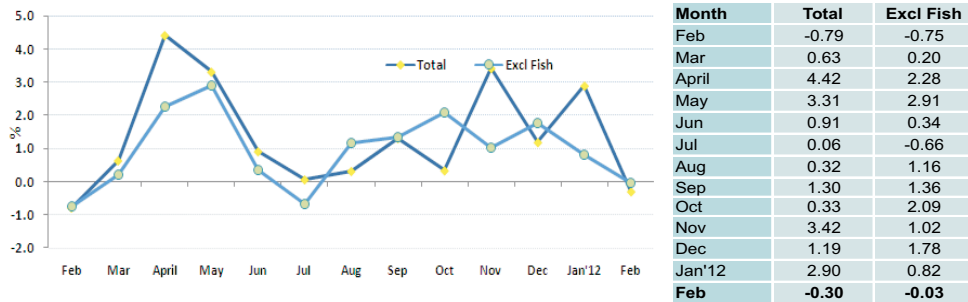


### 1. Inflation Rate of Male' (Monthly): January 2012 compared to February 2012

To measure month to month inflation, this month's index is compared with the previous month inflation (for e.g :February '12/January '12). The monthly inflation for February 2012 is -0.30% and - 0.03% is the total excluding fish.

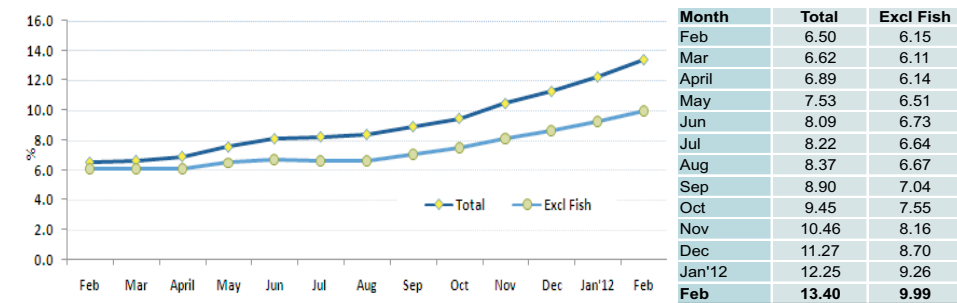
Figure 7. Monthly Inflation Rate of Male', January 2012 - February 2012 (compared to the previous month)



### 2. Inflation Rate of Male' (Annualized): March '11 to February '12 / March '10 to February '11

The annualized inflation rate for any month compares the average for the 12 monthly indices with that of the preceding 12 months (Eg: March '11 to February '12 / March '10 to February '11). This index shows an annual inflation of 13.40%, and the annualized total excluding fish is 9.99%.

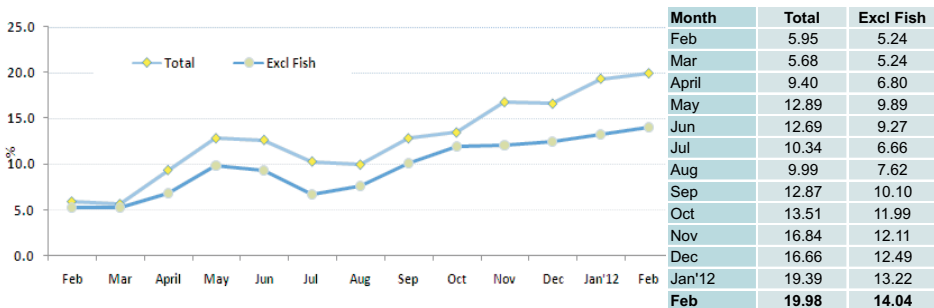
Figure 8. Annualized Inflation Rate of Male' (compared to the past 12 month period)



### 3. Inflation Rate of Male' (month on month): February '12 / February '11

To measure the month on month change at one point in time, the index of the month is compared with that of the same month in the preceding year (Eg :February '12 /February '11). The month on month index for February shows an inflation of 19.98% and the inflation excluding fish is 14.04%.

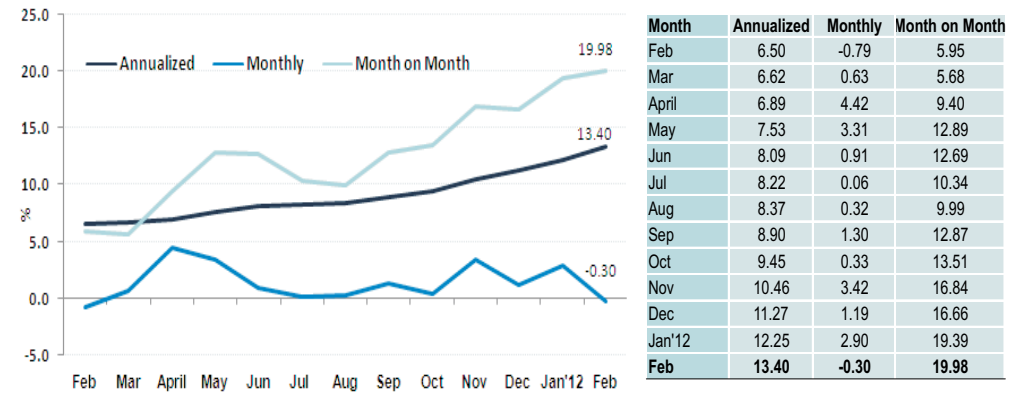
### Inflation Rate of Male'

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) for Male' rose at an annualized rate of 13.40 percent in February 2012. The inflation was driven mainly by fish, food & beverages and transport categories.

Monthly CPI of February 2012 decreased by 0.30 percent compared to January 2012. The deflation was mainly driven from food & beverages followed by fish and transport categories.

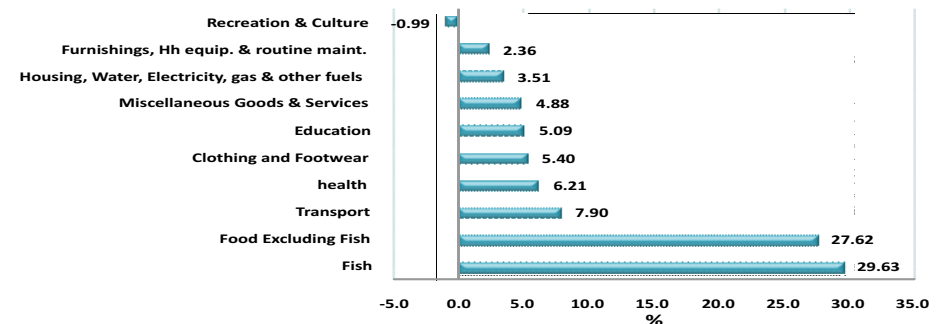
When February 2012 is compared to February 2011, the consumer price index increased by 19.98 percent. Fish category showed the highest inflation followed by tobacco and hotel, cafes & restaurants categories.

Figure 2: Sources of changes in February CPI - Annualized



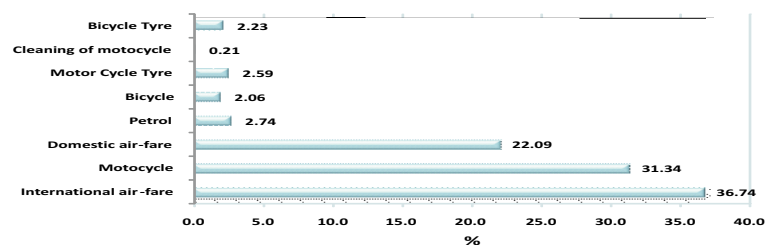
## Major contributors to the change in the CPI - Annualized basis

The largest upward contribution to the change in the annual CPI came from fish which contributed 30%. Other tuna, skipjack tuna and reef fish prices went up by 62%, 56% and 48% respectively. Additionally smoked fish and canned tuna prices went up by 46% and 19% respectively. Dried fish chips also contributed to this hike.

The second largest upward contribution to the change in annual CPI came food & beverages category which contributed 28%. Milo prices went up by 32%. Dried chilli prices went up by 30% and both cooking oil and coca-cola prices went up by 29%. Other items in this category which showed a price increase above 25% were frozen chicken, apollo, chicken drumsticks, chicken sausage, cream cracker biscuits, marjerine, teabag and canned pineapple. Items which registered a price increase between 20% and 25% were, milk powder, watermelon, condensed milk, curry powder, chilli & garlic sauce, frozen beef, chilli sauce, nestum and nescafe coffee. In addition to this, aracanut prices went up by 52%, and cigarette price by 28%. On the other hand, ginger, mango, onion and dates prices decreased by 31%, 29%, 28% & 10% respectively.

The third largest upward contribution to the change in the annualized CPI came from transport category by 8%. International airfare prices contributed highest to inflation of this category with 37%, while International airfare prices increased by 24%. Motorcycle prices contributed 31% to inflation of this category. Domestic airfare contributed 22%, while domestic airfare prices rose by 18%.

## Change in the CPI - Month on Month

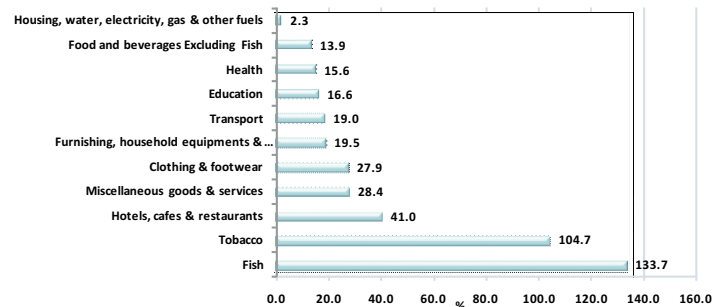
When February 2012 was compared to February 2011 all the major categories recorded an inflation. Fish showed the highest inflation with 134% followed by tobacco at 105%. The third highest category was hotels, cafes & restaurants which registered 41%.

As for fish, other tuna, skipjack tuna and smoked fish prices increased significantly. Additionally reef fish and canned fish prices went up by 56% and 13% compared to February 2011.

For the tobacco category, on average cigarette prices increased by 112% when compared to February 2011. Additionally aracanut prices went up by 101% when the two point of time were compared.

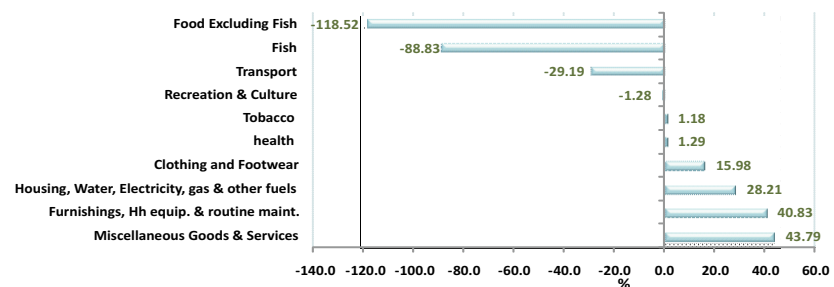
As for hotels, cafes & restaurants category, on an average breakfast meals prices went up by 65%. Additionally pizza prices and restaurant meals prices went up by 42% and 31% respectively.

Food & beverages pulled down the monthly inflation by 119%, where as miscellaneous goods & services category pulled up the overall monthly inflation by 44%.

Fish and transport categories also contributed 89% and 29% respectively to pulled down the monthly inflation. While furnishing, household equipment & routine maintenance and housing, water, electricity, gas & other fuels pulled up the overall monthly inflation by 41% and 28% respectively.

In the miscellaneous category, personal care items such as facial cream, shampoo hair cream, baby diapers, sanitary pads and tooth paste registered a price increase in february.

As for furnishing, household equipment & routine maintenance category, plastic chair prices went up by 6% compared to January 2012. Additionally, washing power, insecticides, linoleum and light tube also contributed to this hike.

As for transport category, international airfare ticket registered a lower price in February compared to january.

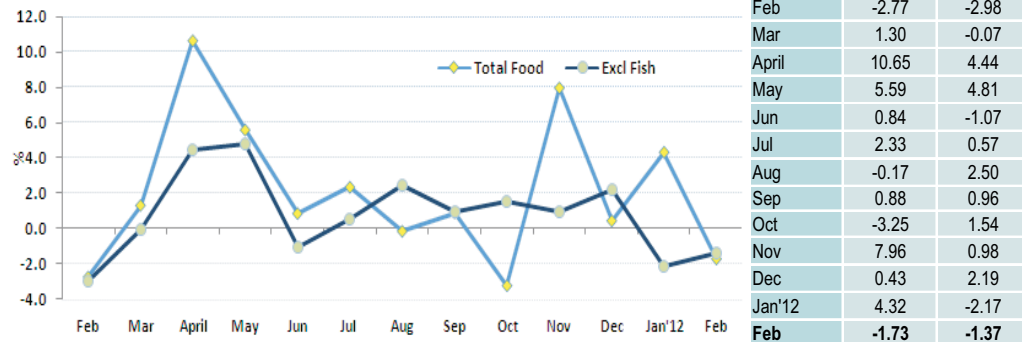
## Monthly inflation rate of food and beverages category

The monthly inflation rate for the food & beverages category is -1.73%. Food excluding fish category showed an inflation of -1.37%.

As for food category, cucumber and carrot prices decreased by 33% to 20% respectively in february when compared to last month. Additionally orange, green chilli price declined by 13% and 11% respectively and both onion and tomato price declined by 10%. Potato, watermelon, mixed fresh vegetables, apple, chicken drumstick and coconut prices also declined in february. While this decrease were the major factors in decline in the food excluding fish index. However items such as garlic, banana, bread spread, dates, corn flake and ginger registered a significantly high price during the month.

The items which contributed to the deflation in the fish category were other fish, reef fish, and smoked fish which showed a price decrease of 13%, 12% and 6% respectively.
