

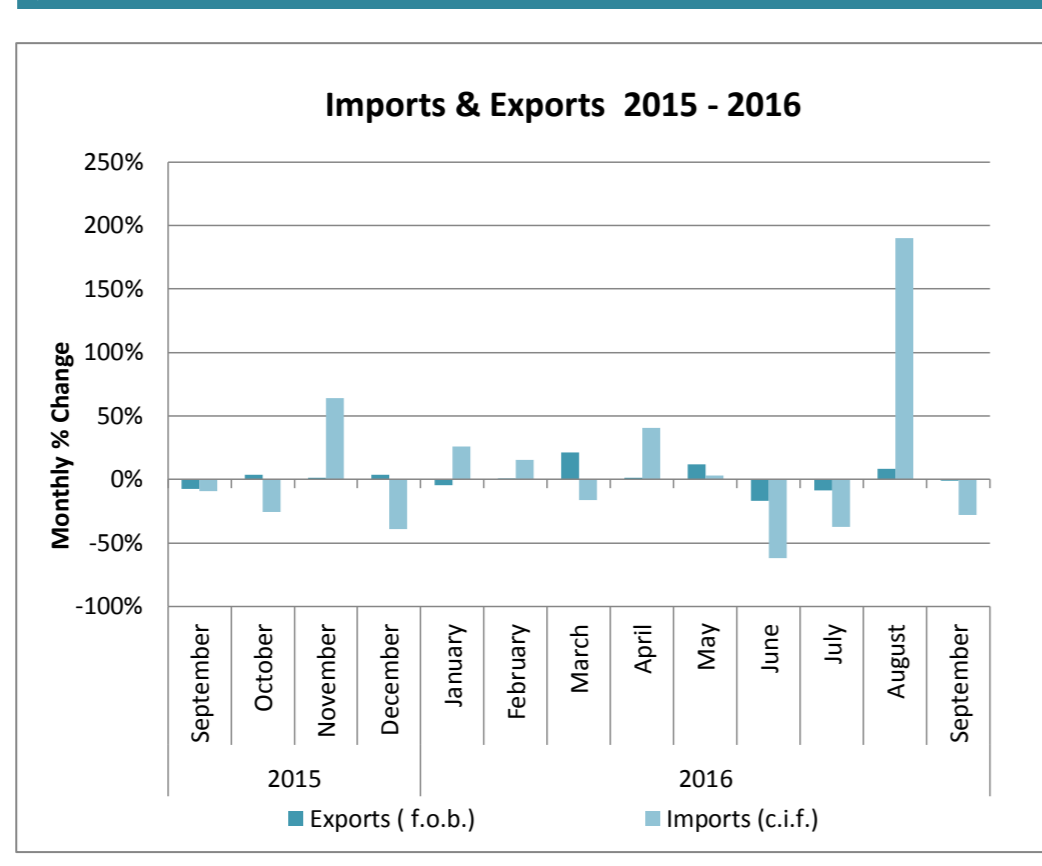

▶ EXCHANGE RATE

In April 2011, the exchange rate regime was changed from a fixed rate regime to a band of 20% around a central parity of Rf12.8 per US\$. The mid point of exchange rate is 12.85 Rufiyaa and the rate is permitted to fluctuate within the ± 20% band, i.e between 10.28 Rufiyaa and 15.42 Rufiyaa.

**TOURISM:-** Growth in tourist arrivals showed an increase of 11.4 percent for the period October 2016 compared to the same period of previous year.

**INFLATION:-** Monthly CPI (Male') for October 2016 has increased by 1.20 percent compared to the previous month.

**FISHERIES:-** Total Fish exports amounted to 2.11 (000' metric tonnes) for the month September 2016.
