



In Maldives 18-34 years is considered as youth age. However Internationally 15-24 is considered as youth age.





Youth Population living in Male'


15 - 24 years 18-34 years 38,414 105,042


Literacy rate in both Dhivehi and English are higher for youth aged 15-24

HIGHEST EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT OF YOUTH BY FIELD OF STUDY




Highest academic/vocational certificate achieved by youth population






Higher secondary enrolment is low with gross enrolment ratio below 50. In 2019 there were 16,167 students in lower secondary while it was 3,776 at higher secondary.

29% of the youth remains without been engaged in any employment, education or training (NEET). NEET is similar for men and women below 22 years. A higher NEET rate is among women after 22 years and is an indication of their time being taken up in upaid domestic work such as cooking, taking care of family members.




