

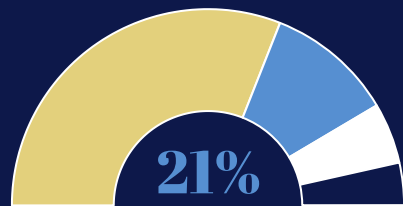

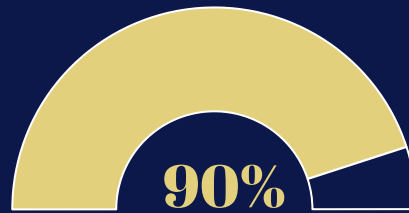
This is the fourth release from an online survey of 2,871 participants with 2,674 complete responses

21% opted for online healthcare

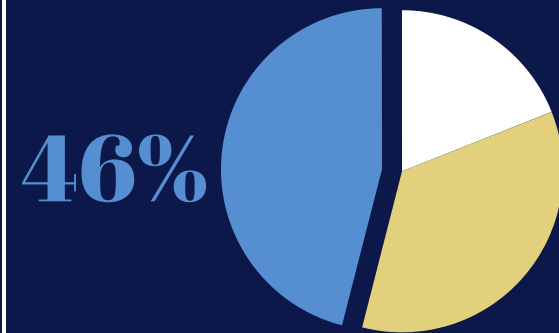

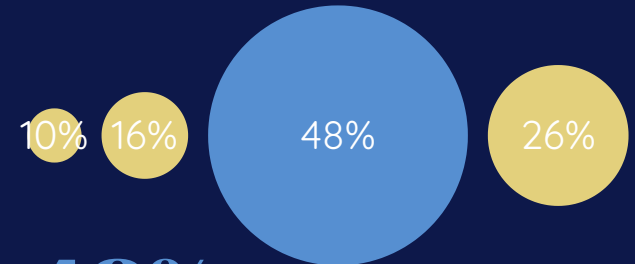

Stress from Confinement



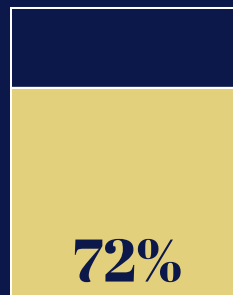

Delivery Service

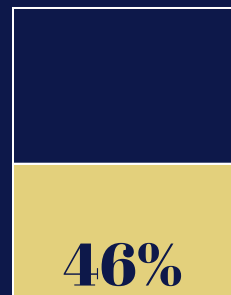


48% used 1-3 times weekly
