



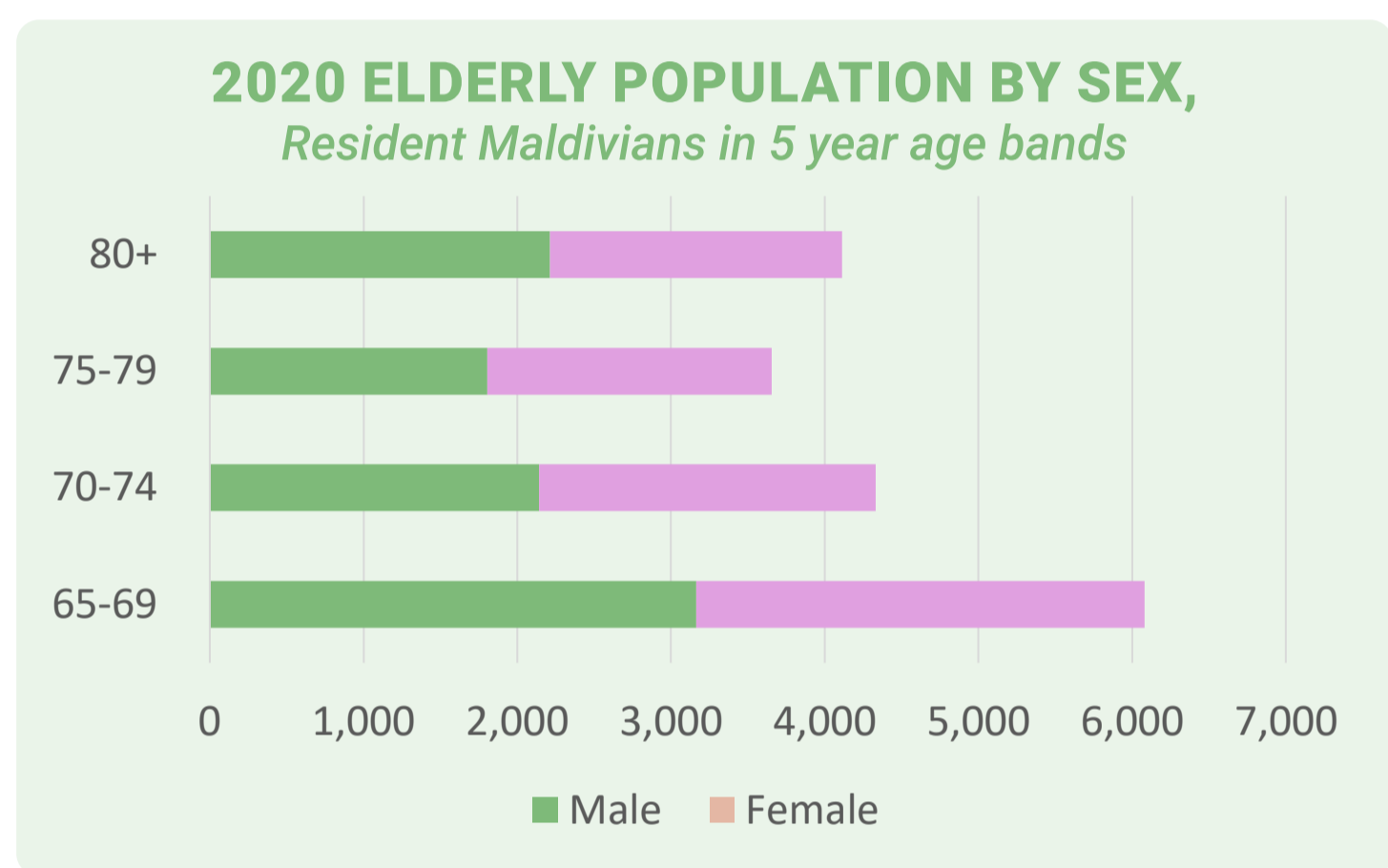

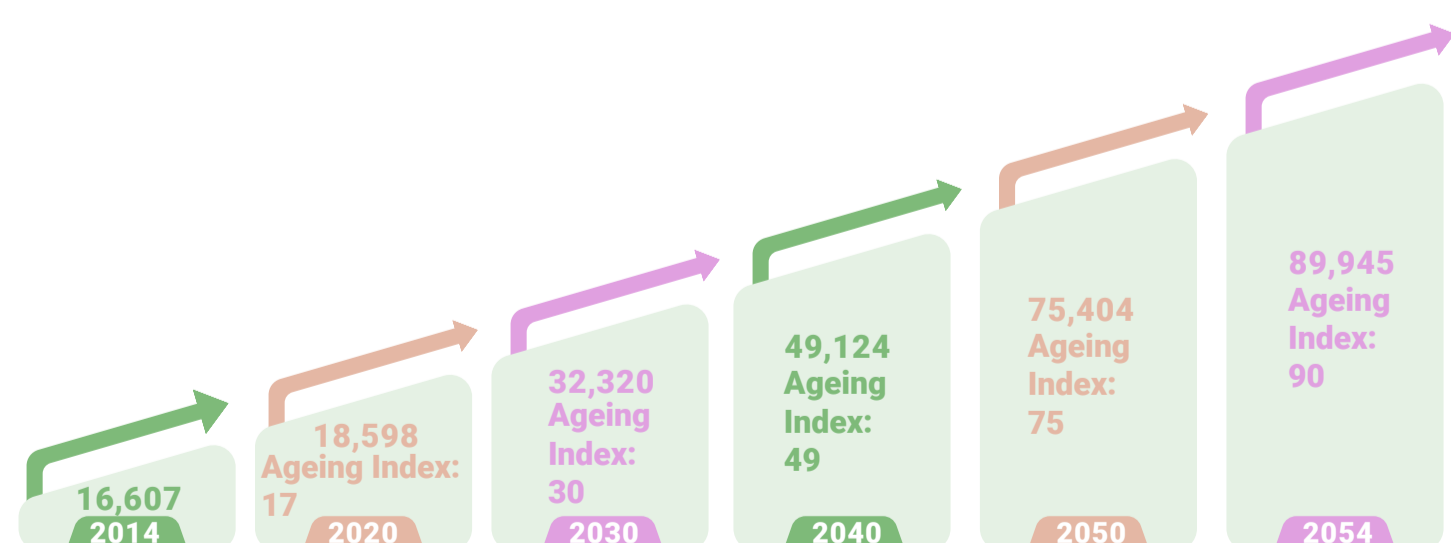

From the 18,178 elderly population, 9,223 lives in Male and 8,955 in Atolls.

During the projection period the elderly population has increased five times its level in 2014 from 16,607 to 89,945 in 2054.

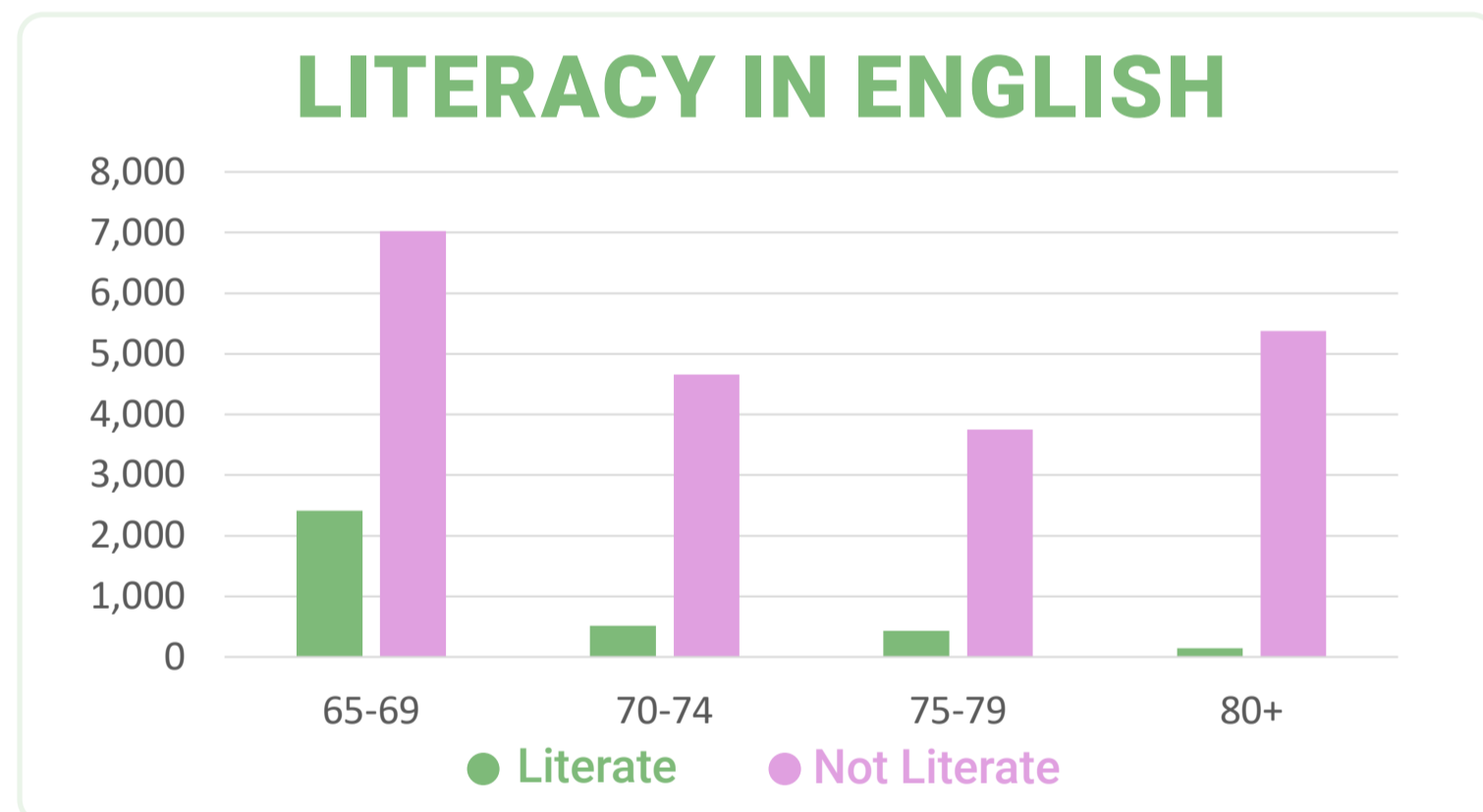
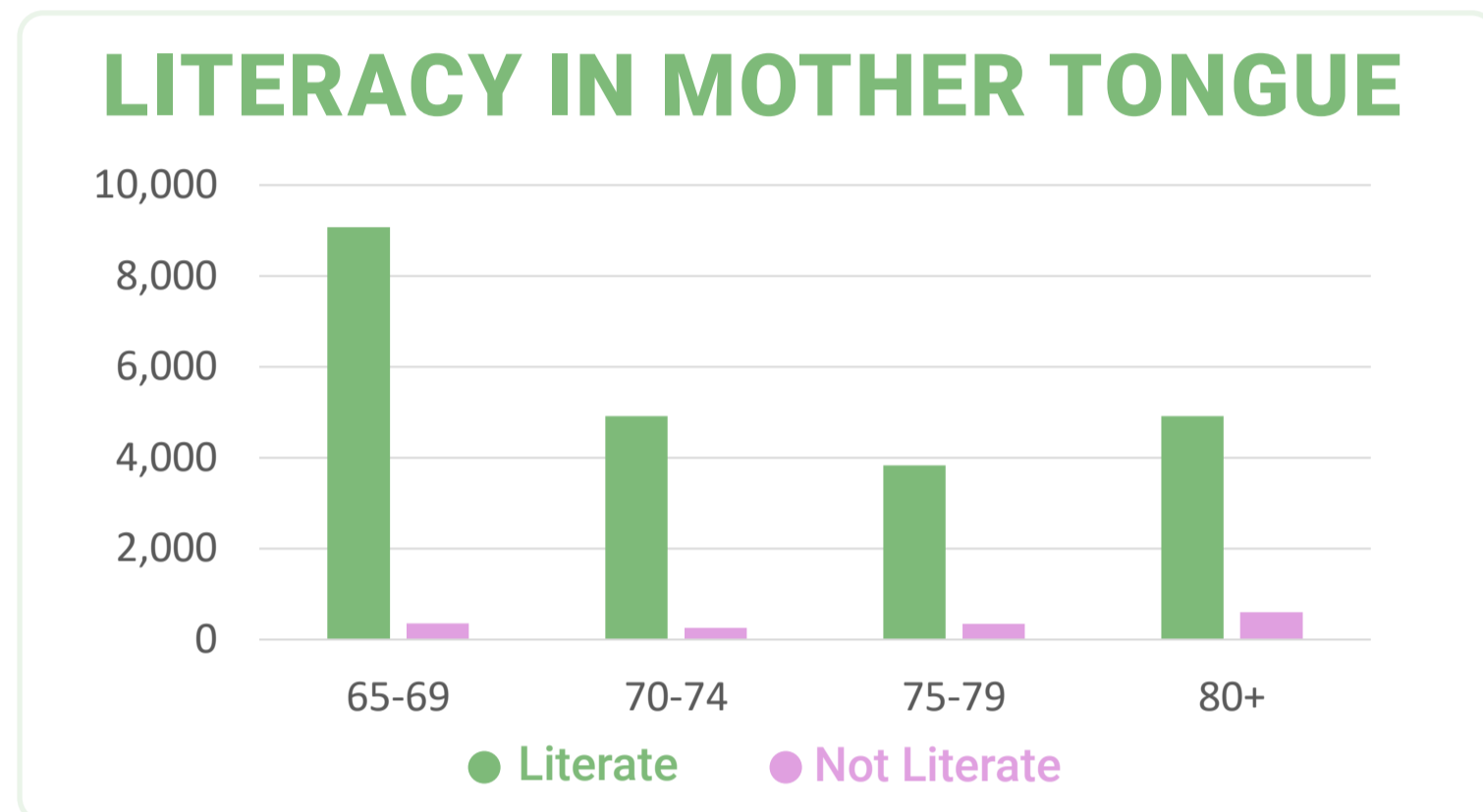


Only 4 percent are elderly aged 65 years and older. If current demographic trends continue, however, by 2030 more than 7percent of the population are projected to be elderly. The share of elderly will reach 14% in 2054 and we will be considered an ageing society.
