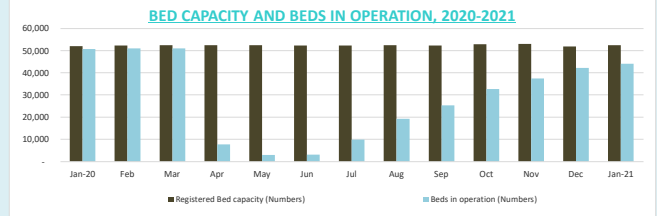
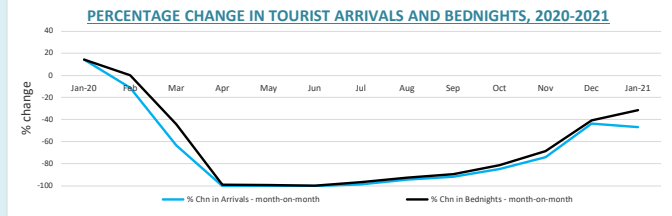

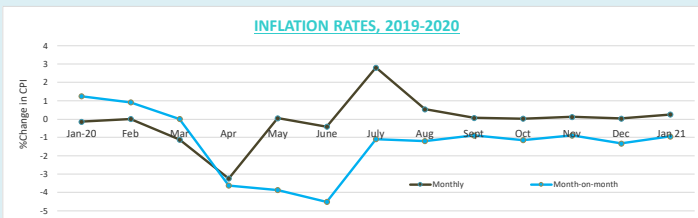


In January 2021, there were 92,111 tourist arrivals, where it showed a decline of 4.5 when compared to December 2020.

The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI fell by -0.95% through the year to Jan 2021, compared to the fall of -1.33% through the year to Dec 2020.

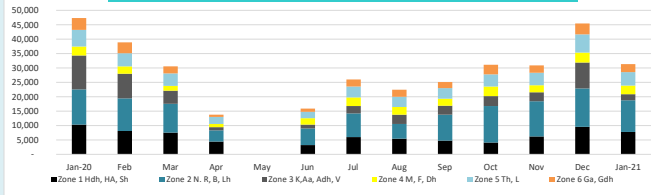

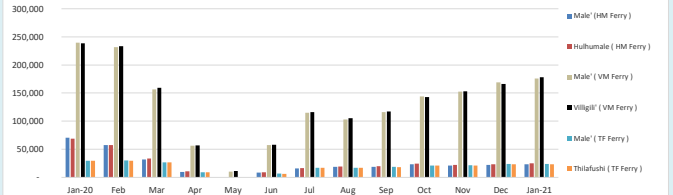

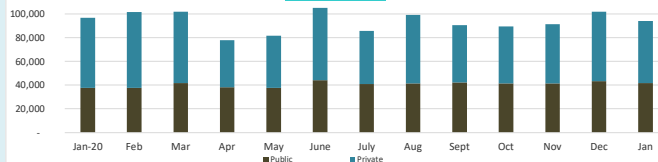

 Electricity produced for Male' was 30,644 ('000 kWh) at the end of December 2020

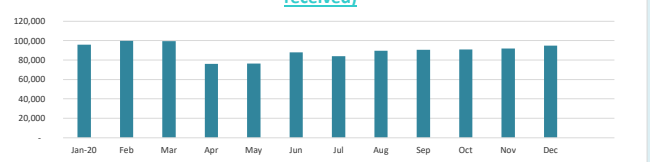

Maldives Retirement Pension Scheme Contributions (In '000 MVR)



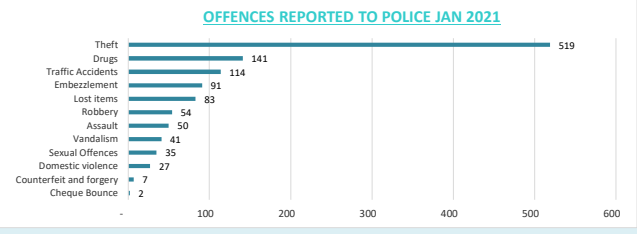
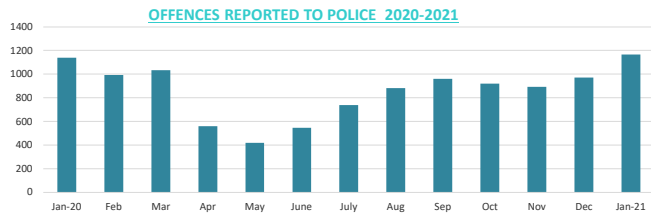
Employees of Retirement Pension Scheme (whose contributions received)

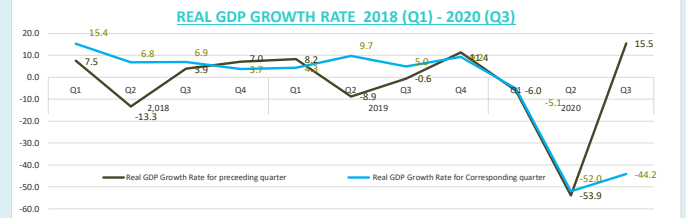
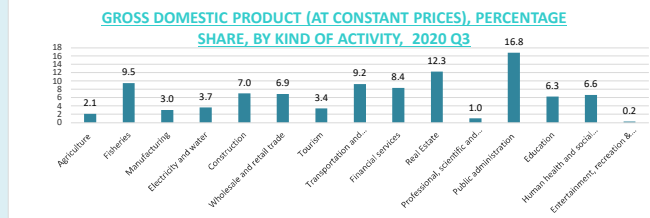
