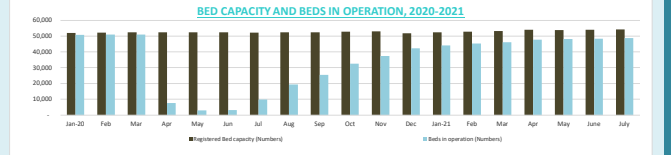
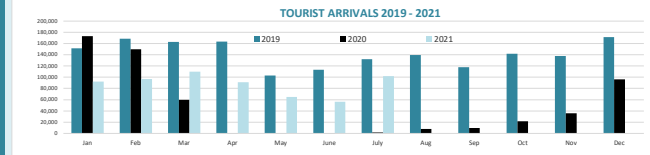

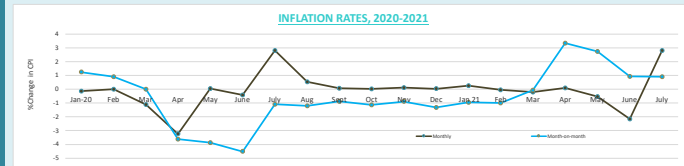


In July 2021, there were 101,818 tourist arrivals, where it showed a huge increase of 81 percent when compared to June 2021.

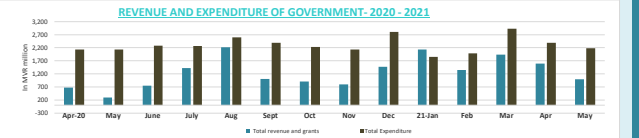
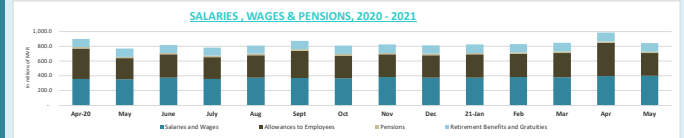
The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI rose by +2.80% in July 2021, compared to the fall of -2.17% in June 2021

CPI rose at the All Group Levels in Male* by +2.70% and rose in Atolls by +2.93% in July 2021.

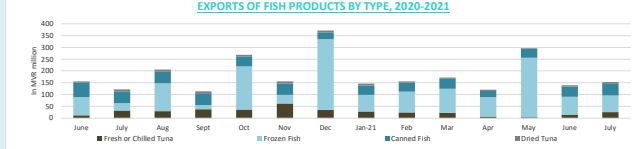
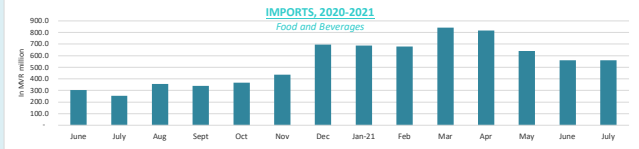
The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI rose by +0.91% through the year to July 2021, compared to the rise of +0.93% through the year to June 2021.

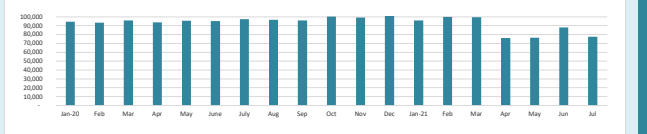

Maldives Retirement Pension Scheme Contributions (in '000 MVR)



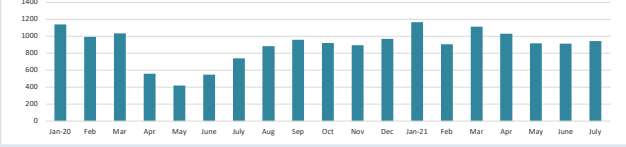
Employees of Retirement Pension Scheme (whose contributions received)



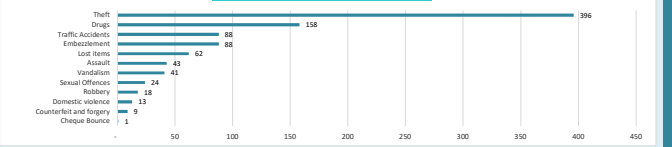

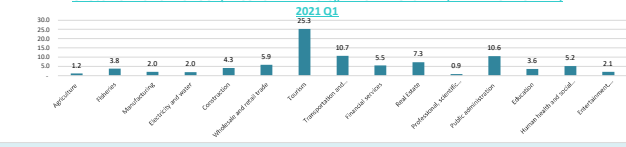

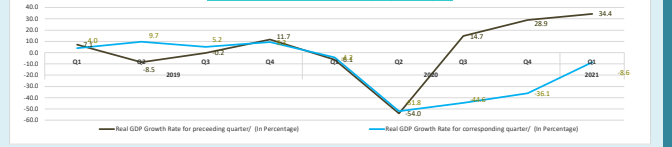
