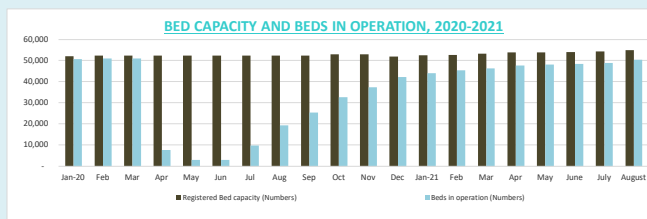
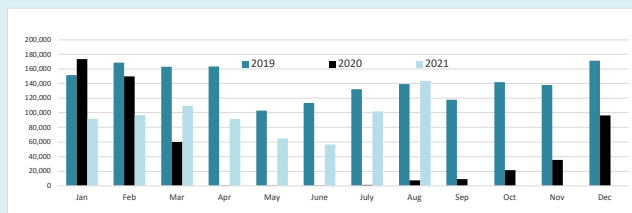

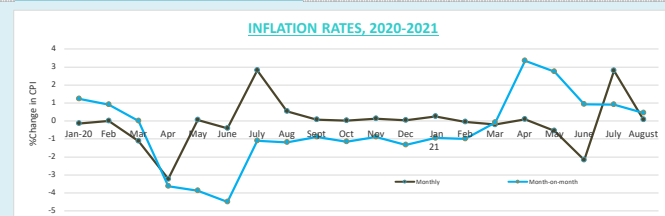
In August 2021, there were 143,599 tourist arrivals, where it showed an increase of 41 percent when compared to July 2021.

The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI rose by +0.08% in August 2021, compared to the rise of +2.80% in July 2021.

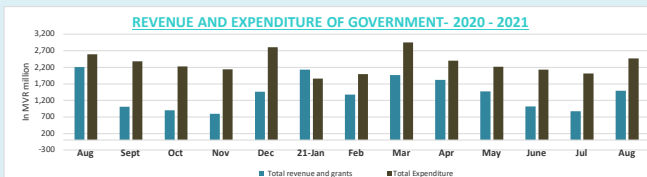
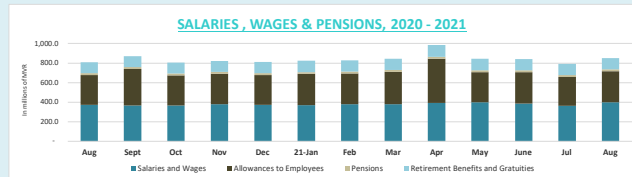
CPI rose at the All Group Levels in Male' by +0.20% and fell in Atolls by -0.08% in August 2021.

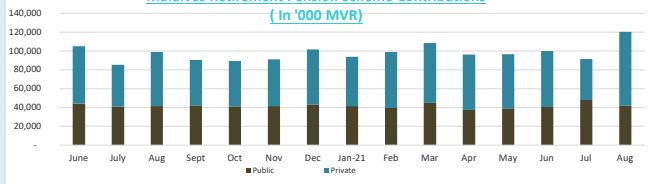

Maldives Retirement Pension Scheme Contributions (In '000 MVR)

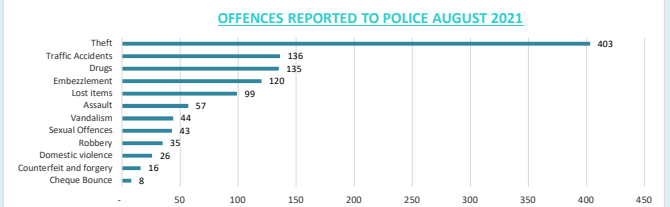
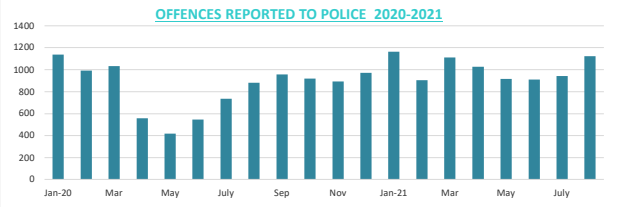


Employees of Retirement Pension Scheme (whose contributions received)

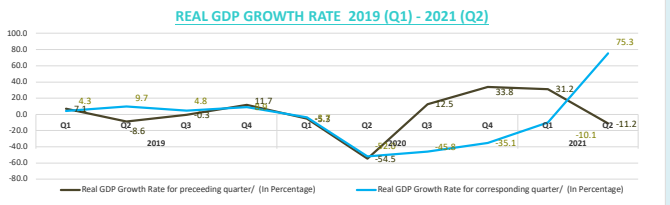
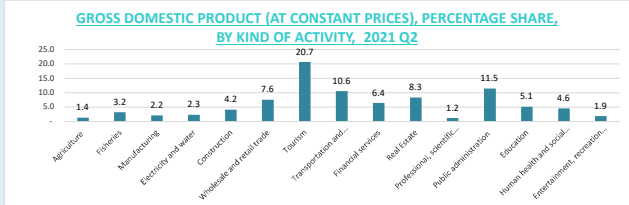
