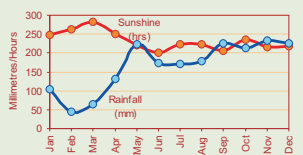

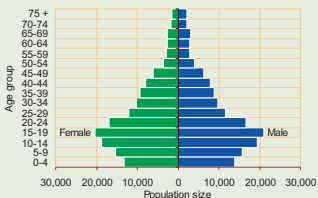
28 YEARS AVERAGE OF MONTHLY SUNSHINE & RAINFALL (MALE), 1975 - 2004

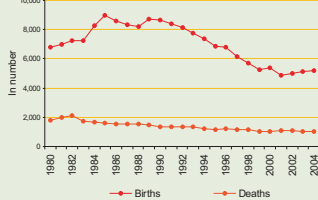

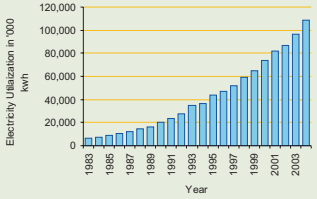

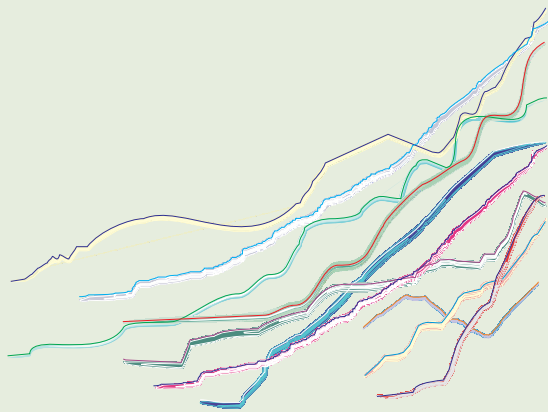
