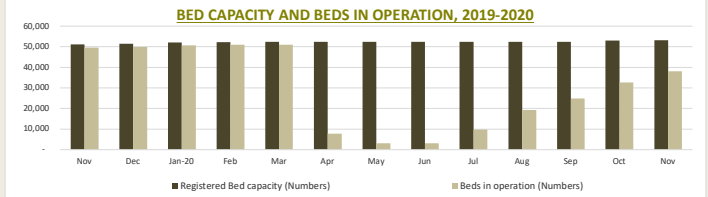
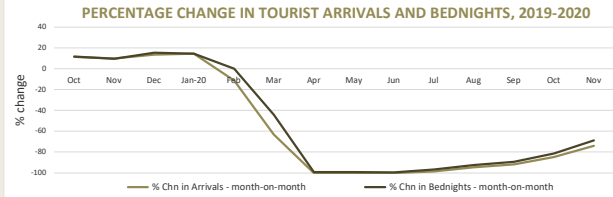

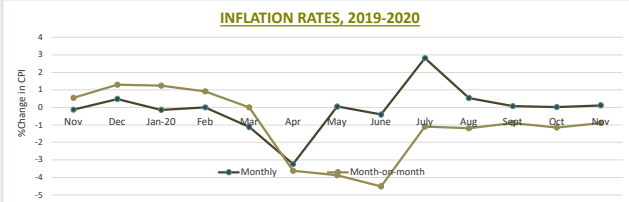
The Bednights for November 2020 recorded was 277,552 showing a 63.5 percent increase compared to September 2020.

The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI rose by +0.12% in Nov 2020, compared to the rise by +0.02% in Oct 2020.

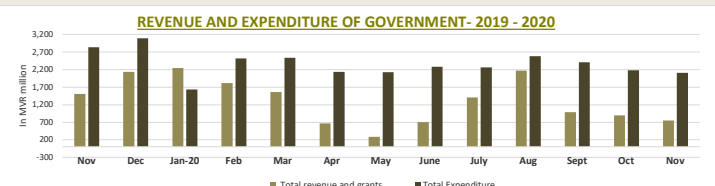
CPI fell at the All Group Levels in Male' by -0.02 and rose in Atolls by +0.31% in Nov 2020.

The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI fell by -0.89% through the year to Nov 2020, compared to the fall of -1.15% through the year to Oct 2020.

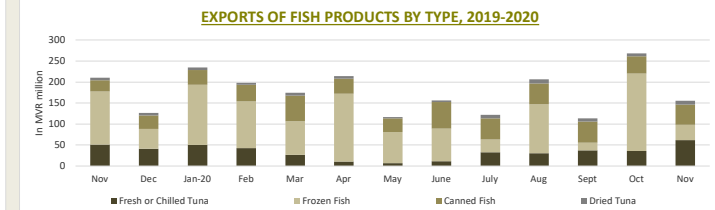

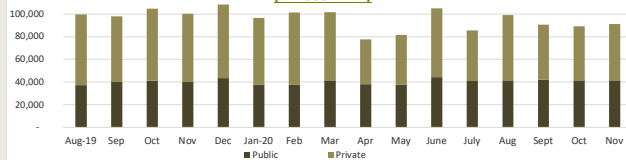

Maldives Retirement Pension Scheme Contributions (In '000 MVR)

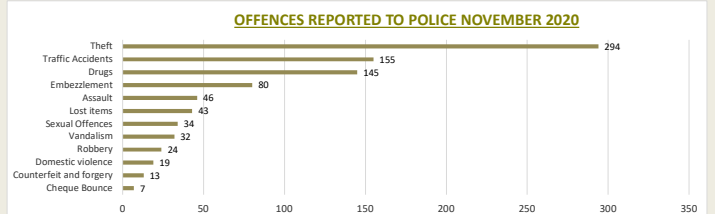
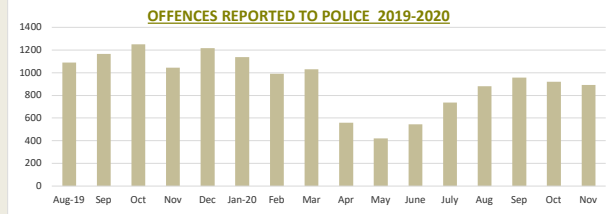


Establishments & employees of Retirement Pension Scheme (whose contributions received)

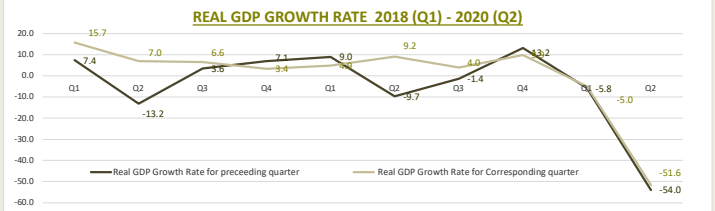
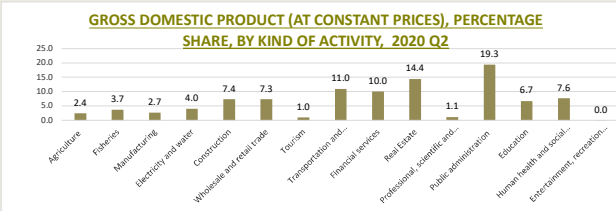
