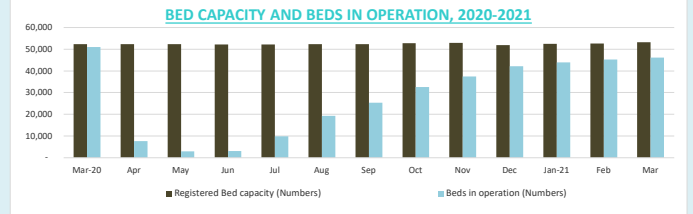
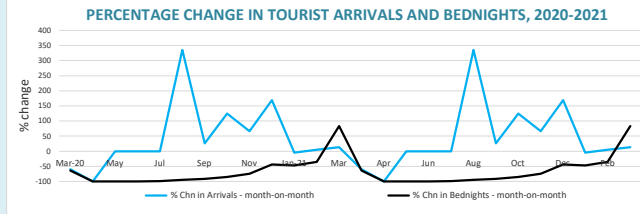

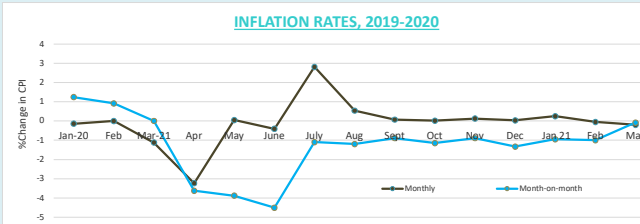


In March 2021, there were 109,585 tourist arrivals, where it showed an increase of 13.1 percent when compared to February 2021.

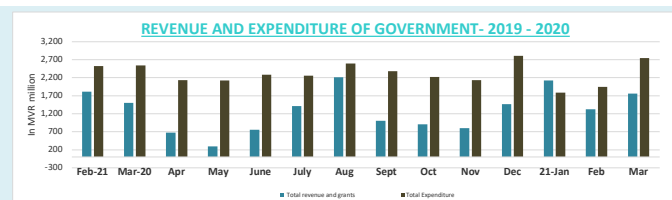
The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI fell by -0.20% in March 2021, compared to the fall by -0.05% in Feb 2021

The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI fell by -0.08% through the year to March 2021, compared to the fall of -1.00% through the year to Feb 2021.

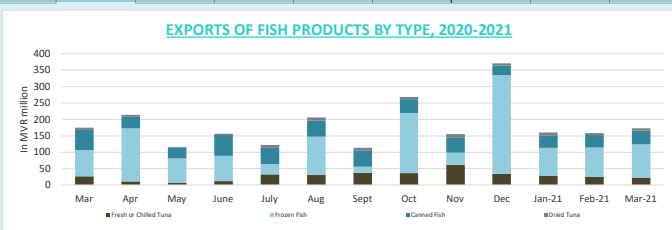

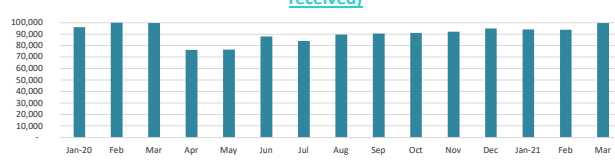

Maldives Retirement Pension Scheme Contributions (in '000 MVR)



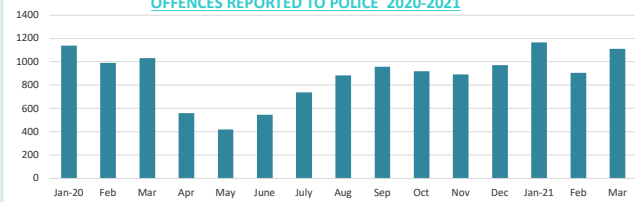
Employees of Retirement Pension Scheme (whose contributions received)



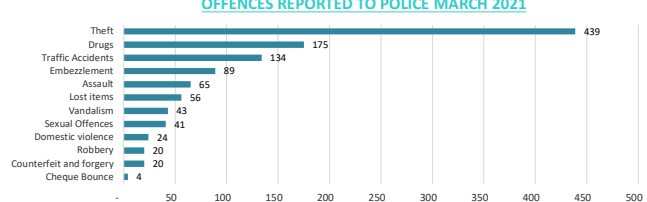

OFFENCES REPORTED TO POLICE MARCH 2021



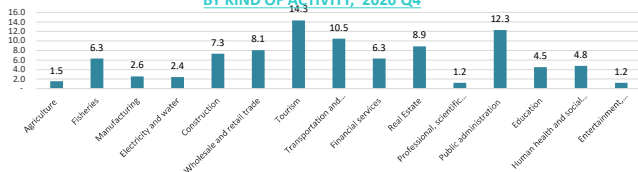

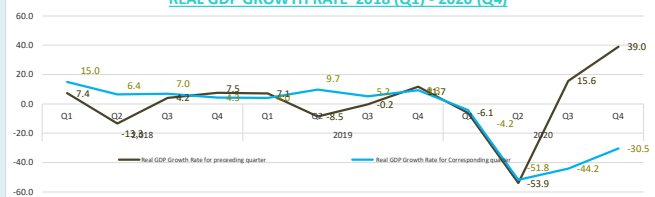
