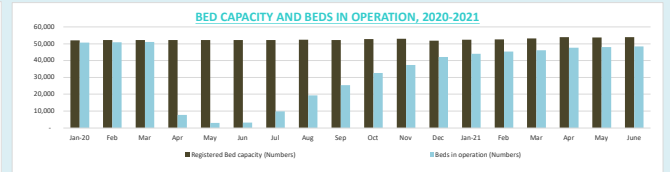
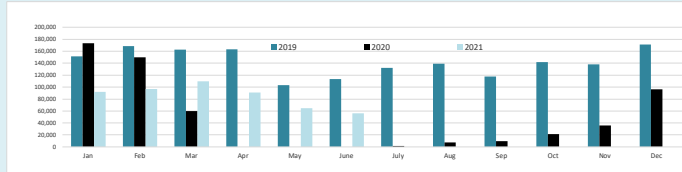

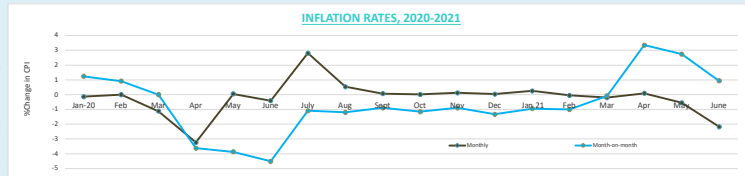

The tourist arrivals in June 2021 when compared with June 2020, it showed a huge increase where during May 2020 tourist arrivals was just 1 tourist with the complete travel restrictions enforced and border being fully closed due to Covid19.

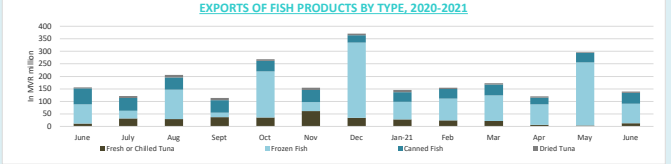
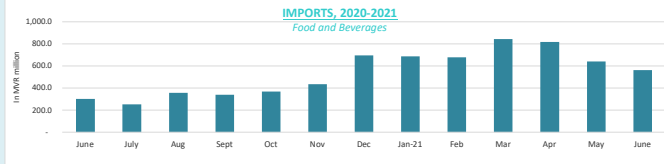
The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI fell by -2.17% in June 2021, compared to the fall of -0.54% in May 2021

CPI fell at the All Group Levels in Male' by -2.12% and fell in Atolls by -2.23% in June 2021.

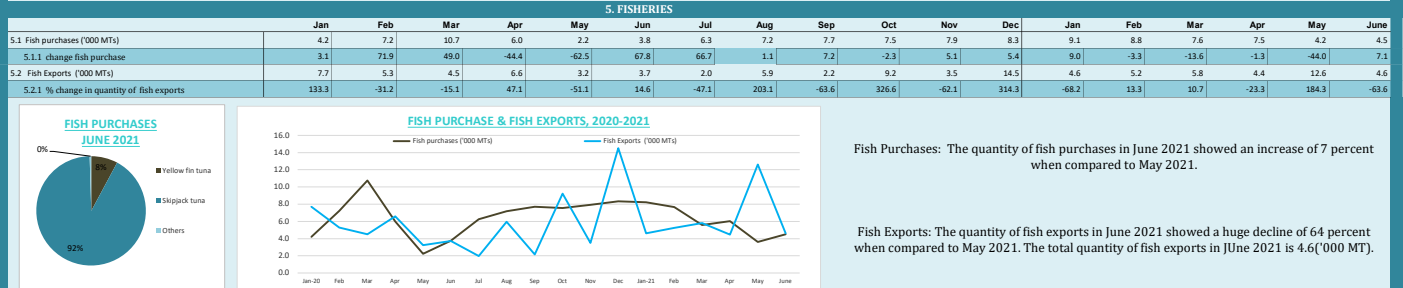
The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI rose by +0.93% through the year to June 2021, compared to the rise of +2.74% through the year to May 2021.
