

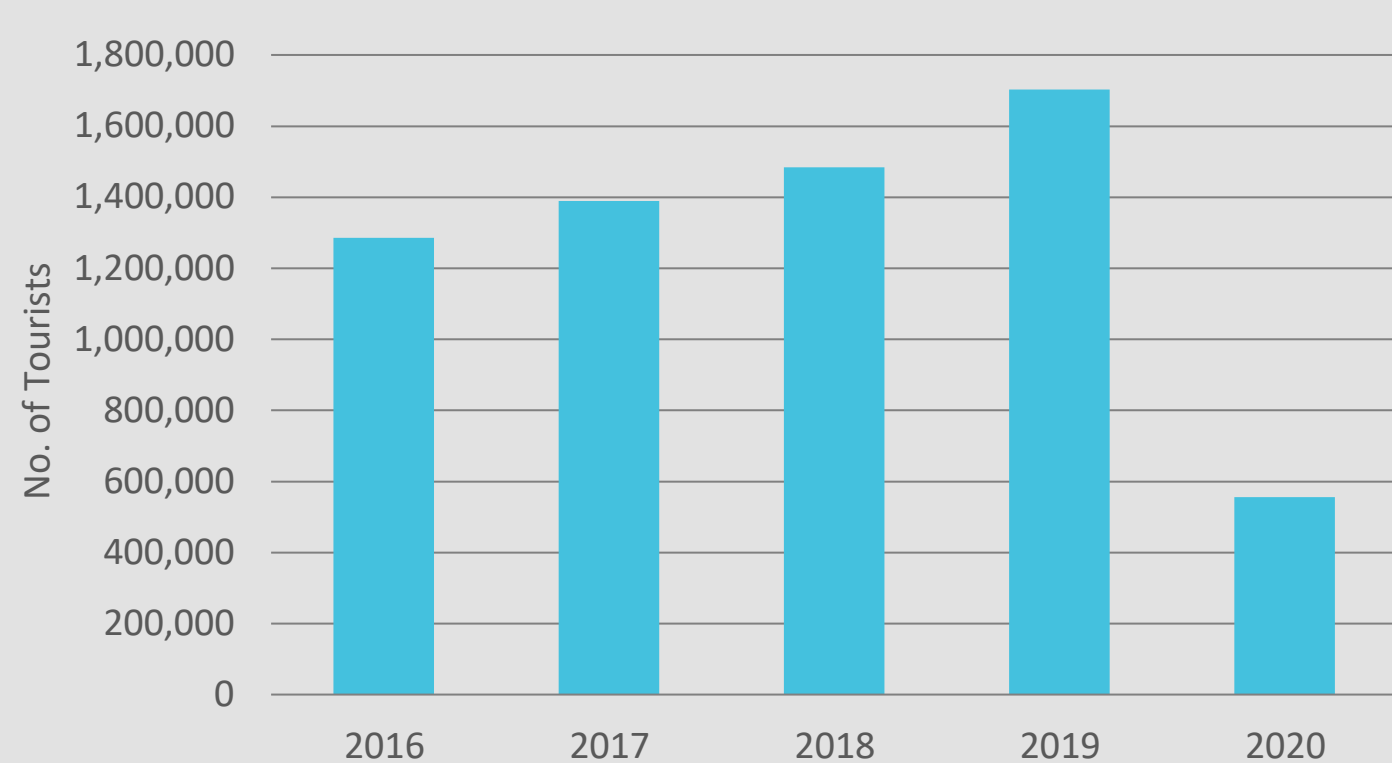
WORLD TOURISM DAY 2021

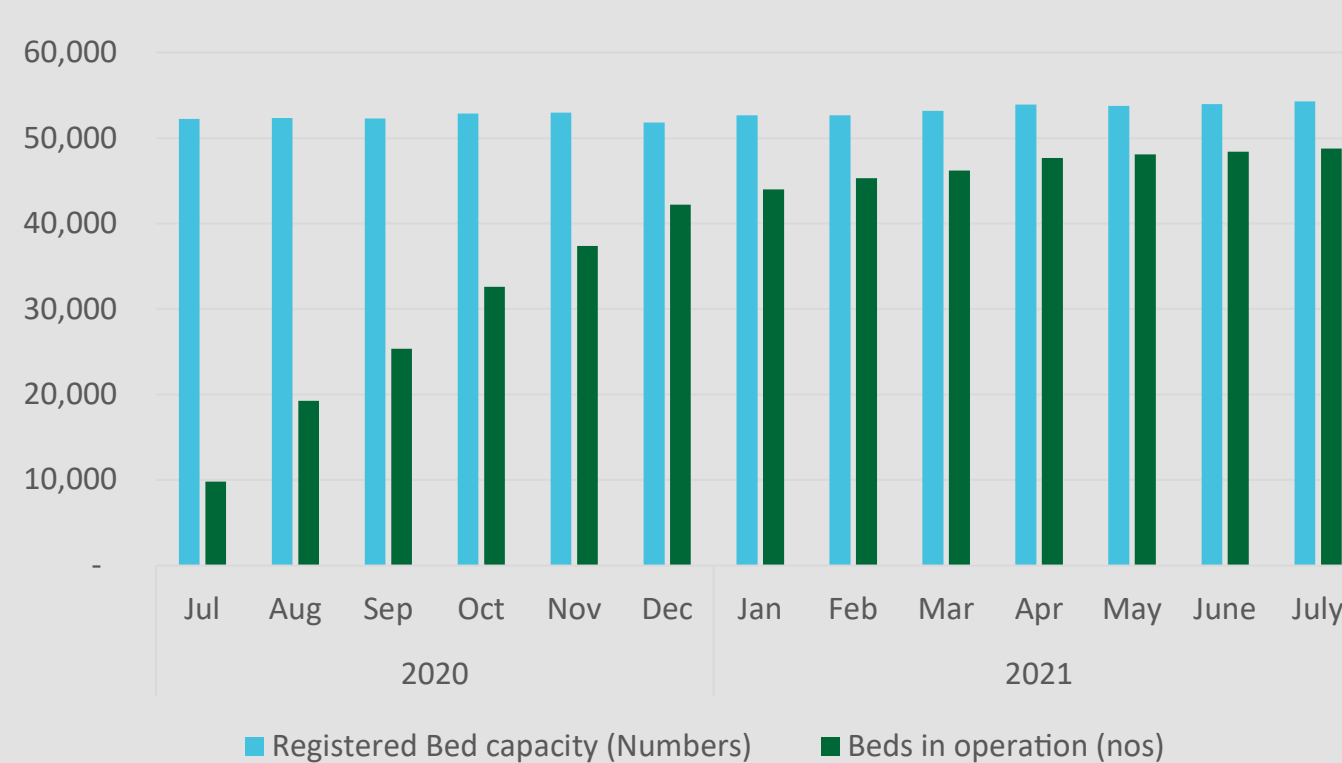

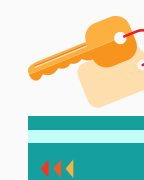

Chinese market dropped from being the top market in 2019 to sixth place, as Chinese arrivals declined by 89% in 2020

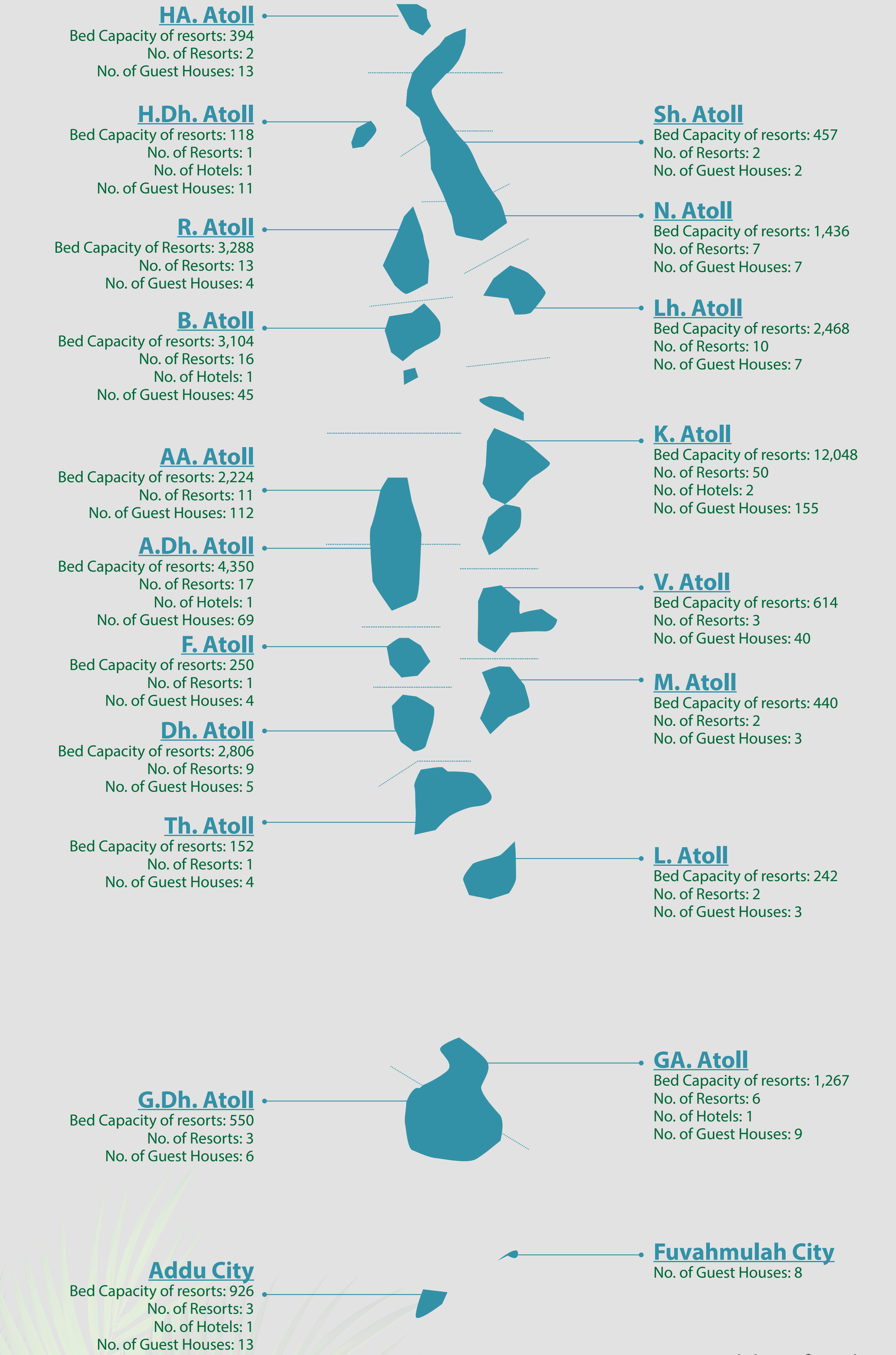
