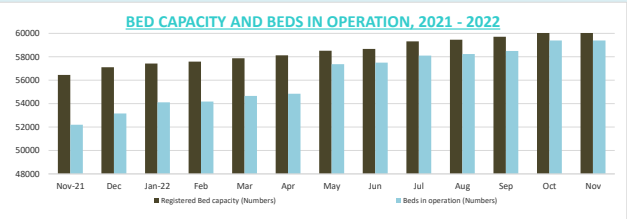
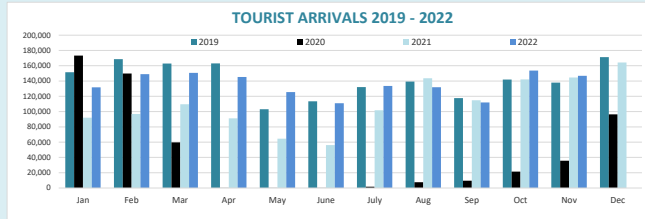

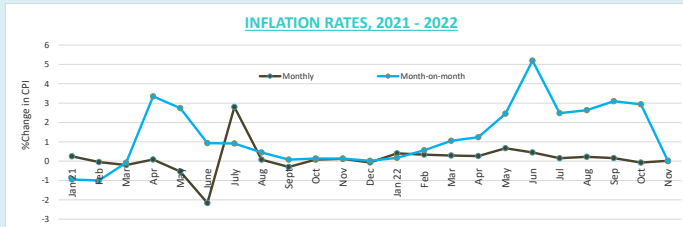


In November 2022, there were 146,886 tourist arrivals, where it showed a decline of 4.5 percent when compared to October 2022.

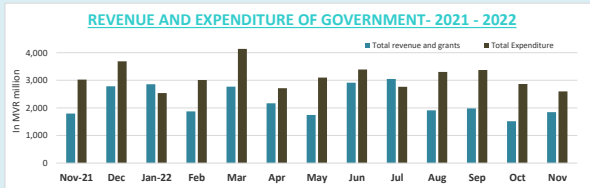
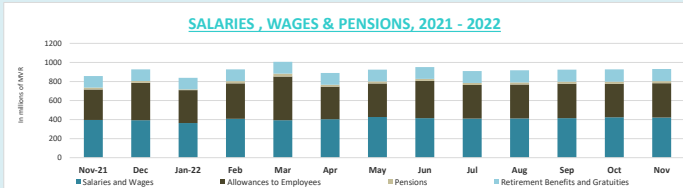
Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI rose by +0.02% in November 2022, compared to the decline of -0.07% in October 2022.

Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI rose by +2.94% through the year to October 2022, compared to the rise of +3.10% through the year to September 2022.

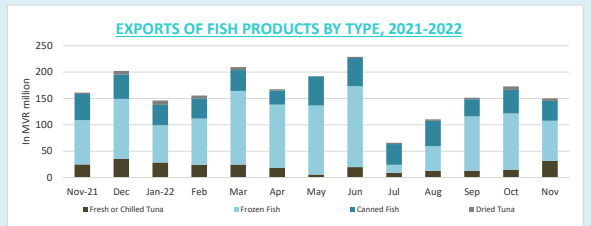

Intra and Inter Atoll Ferry passenger movement, 2022

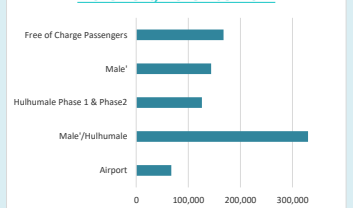


Male' area Ferry passenger movement, 2022

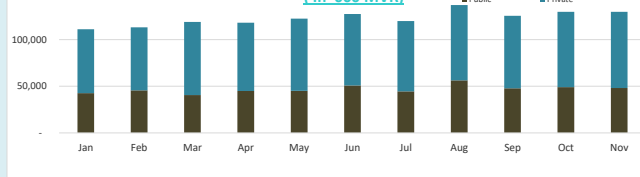

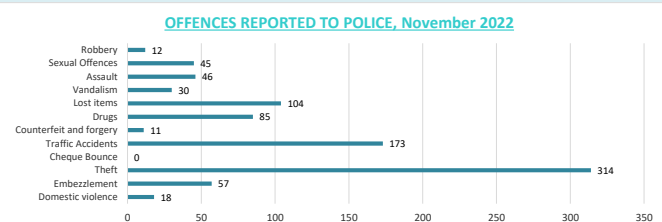
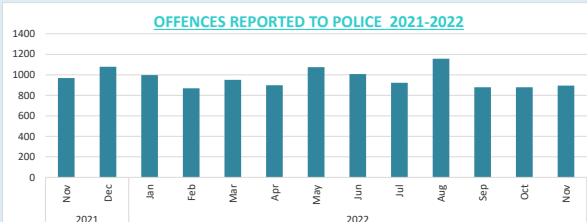


Employees of Retirement Pension Scheme (whose contributions received)

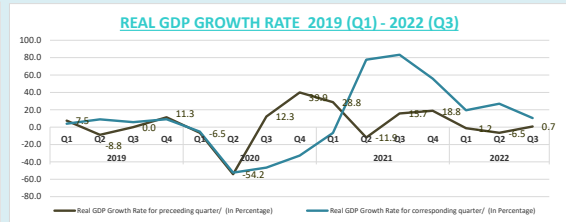
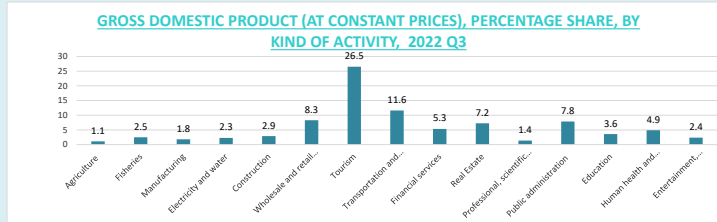
