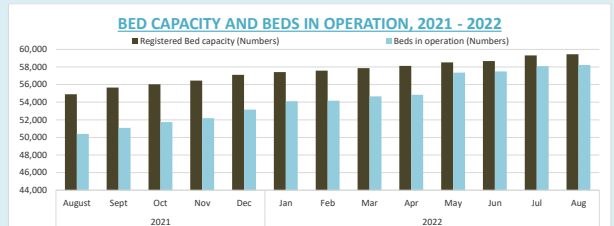
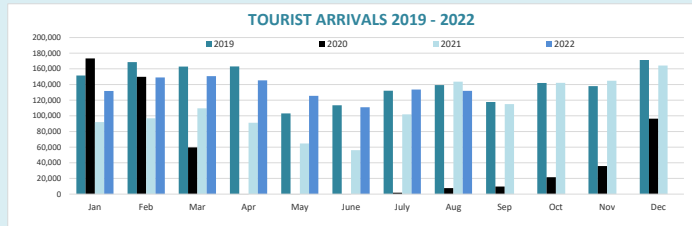

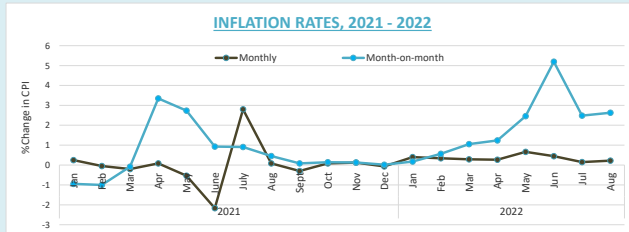


In August 2022, there were 131,862 tourist arrivals, where it showed a decrease of 1.3 percent when compared to July 2022.

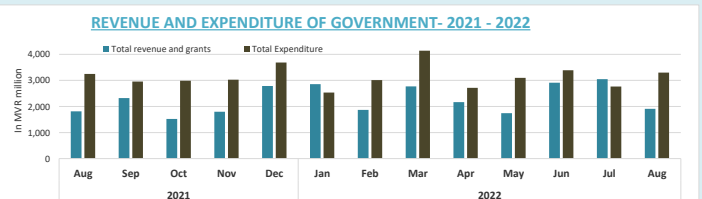
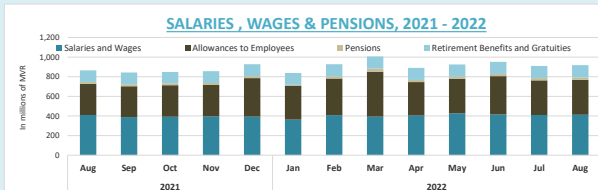
Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI rose by +0.22% in August 2022, compared to the increment of +0.15% in July 2022.

Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI rose by +2.63% through the year to August 2022, compared to the rise of +2.48% through the year to July 2022.

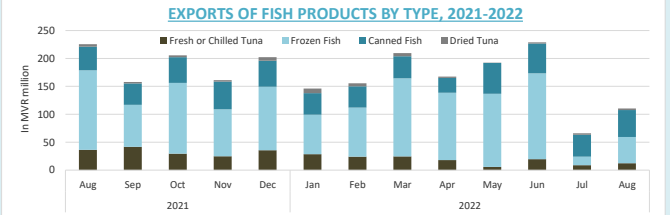
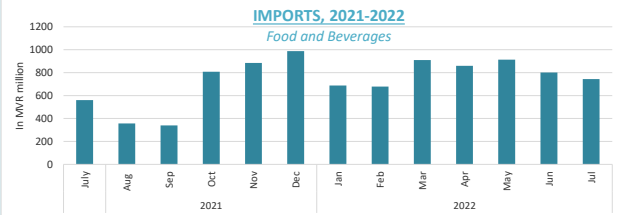

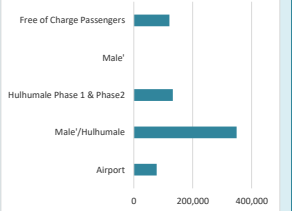
Intra and Inter atoll ferry passenger movement, 2022

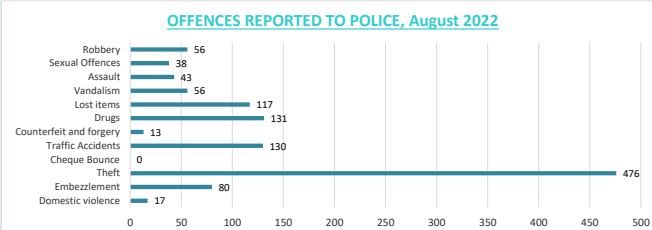
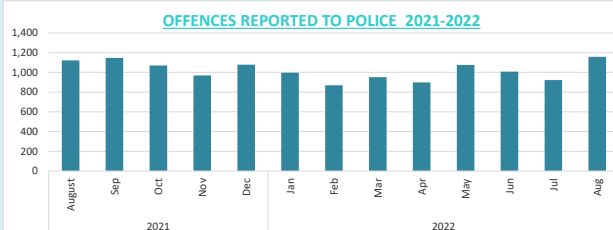


Employees of Retirement Pension Scheme (whose contributions received)

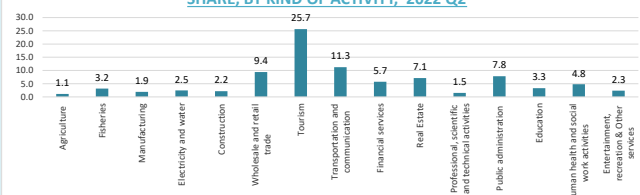

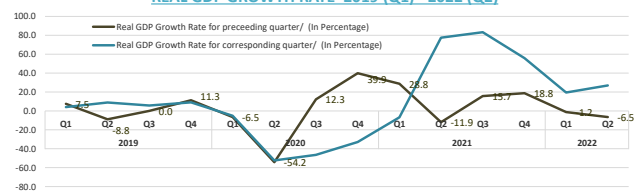
