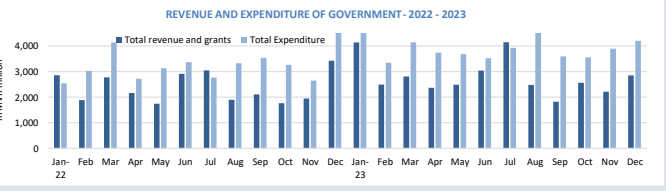
The increase in Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all groups was +0.39% in December 2023, compared to the decrease of -0.48% in November 2023.

In December 2023, the Consumer Price Index excluding fish rose by +0.33%, compared to the decrease of -0.50% in November 2023.

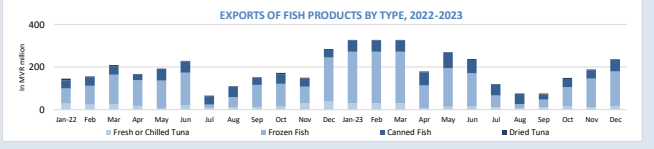
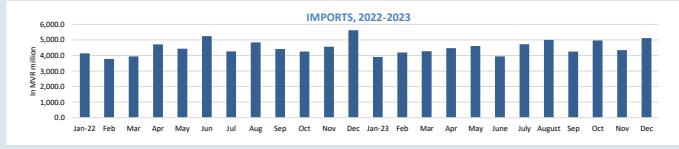
The Consumer Price Index for all groups rose by +2.02% through the year to December 2023, compared to the rise of +2.13% through the year to November 2023.
