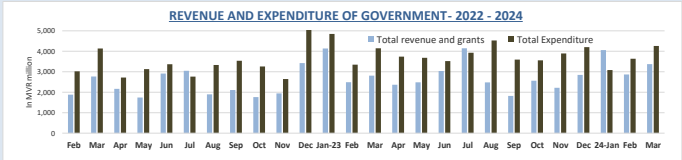
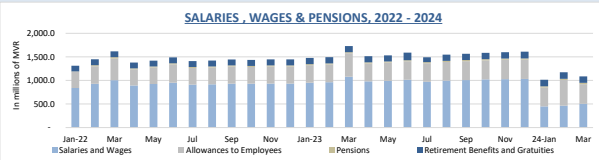
The increase in Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all groups was +0.73% in June 2024, compared to the increase of +1.51% in May 2024.

In June 2024, the Consumer Price Index excluding fish rose by +0.74%, compared to the increase of +1.69% in May 2024.

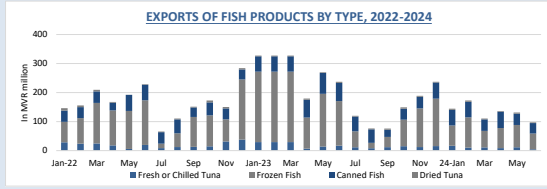
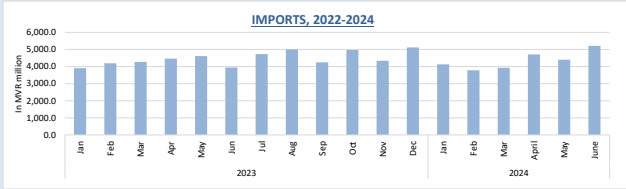
The Consumer Price Index for all groups rose by +1.40% throughout the year to June 2024, compared to the rise of +0.77% through the year to May 2024.
