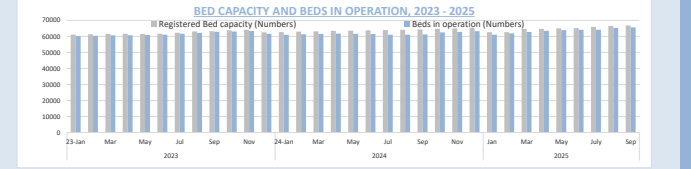

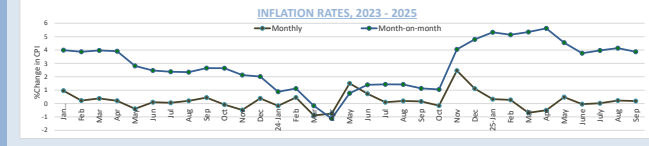

In September 2025, there were 149,563 tourist arrivals, where it showed a decline of 22.1 percent when compared to August 2025. The bednights for September 2025 recorded is 920,810 showing a decline of 25.5 percent compared to August 2025. In September 2025 the registered bed capacity was at 66,852 where the beds in operation stood at 65,654.

The decrease in Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all groups was by -0.09% in September 2025, compared to the increase of +0.36% in August 2025.

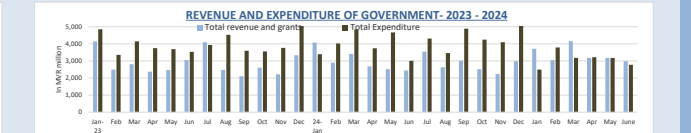
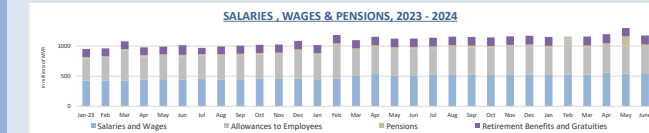
In September 2025, the Consumer Price Index (CPI) excluding fish rose by +0.04%, compared to the increase of +0.20% in August 2025.

The Consumer Price Index for all groups rose by +3.87% from September 2024 to September 2025, compared to the rise of +4.14% between August 2024 and August 2025.

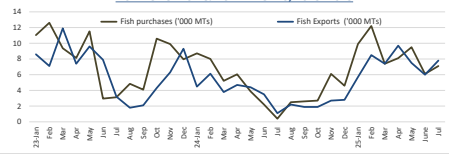

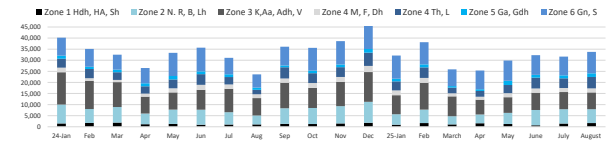

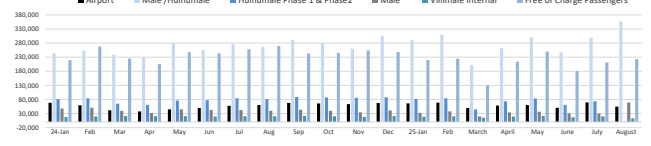

Male* area Bus passenger movement 2024-2025



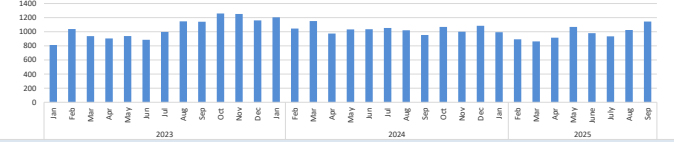

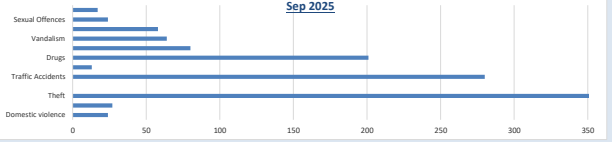

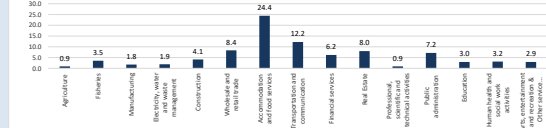

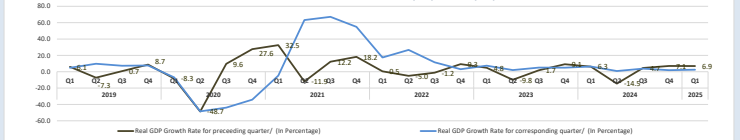
