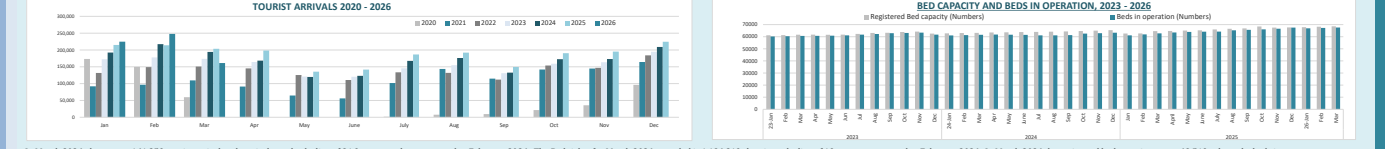

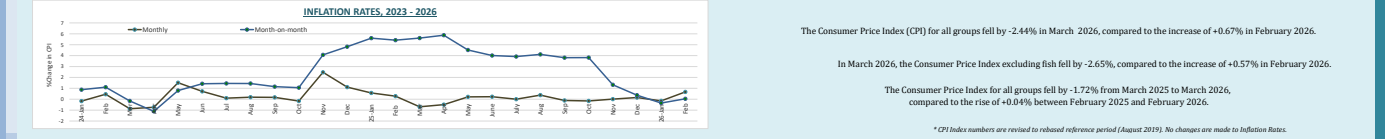

The bednights for March 2026 recorded is 1,186,219 showing a decline of 19 percent compared to February 2026. In March 2026 the registered bed capacity was at 68,549 where the beds in operation stood at 67,581.

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all groups fell by -2.44% in March 2026, compared to the increase of +0.67% in February 2026.

In March 2026, the Consumer Price Index excluding fish fell by -2.65%, compared to the increase of +0.57% in February 2026.

The Consumer Price Index for all groups fell by -1.72% from March 2025 to March 2026, compared to the rise of +0.04% between February 2025 and February 2026.

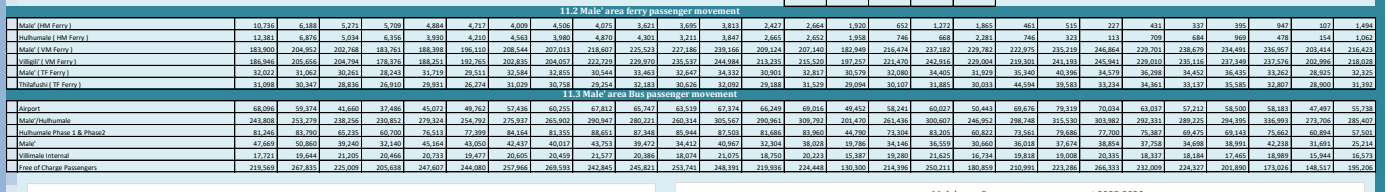

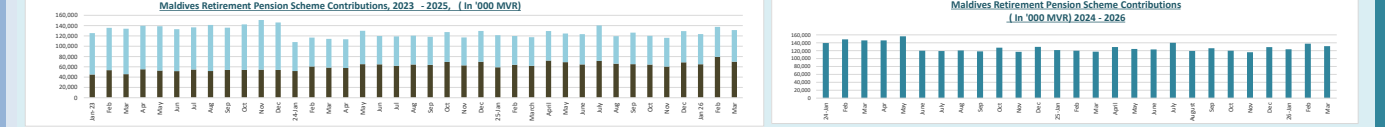
