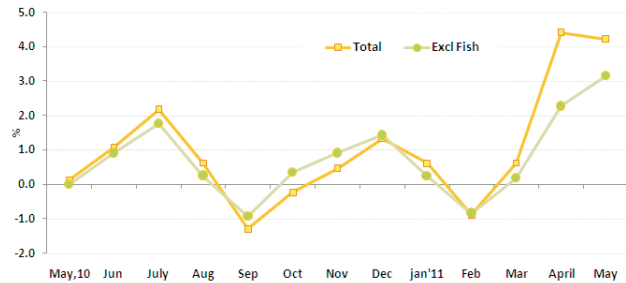


1. Inflation Rate of Male' (Monthly): May 2011 compared to April 2011

To measure month to month inflation, this month's index is compared with the previous month inflation (for e.g : May '11 and April'11). The monthly inflation for May 2011 is 4.23% and 3.16% is the total excluding fish.

Figure 7. Monthly Inflation Rate of Male', May 2010 - May 2011 (compared to the previous month)

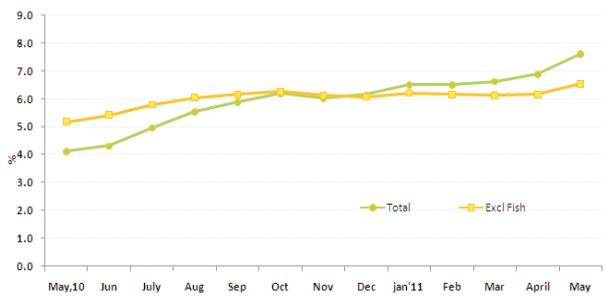

2. Inflation Rate of Male' (Annualized): June '10 to May '11 / June'09 to May '10

The annualized inflation rate for any month compares the average for the 12 monthly indices with that of the preceding 12 months (Eg: June'10 to May'11 / June'09 to May'10). This index shows an annual inflation of 7.62%, and the annualized total excluding fish is 6.54%.

Figure 8. Inflation Rate of Male', May 2010 - May 2011 (compared to the past 12 month period)

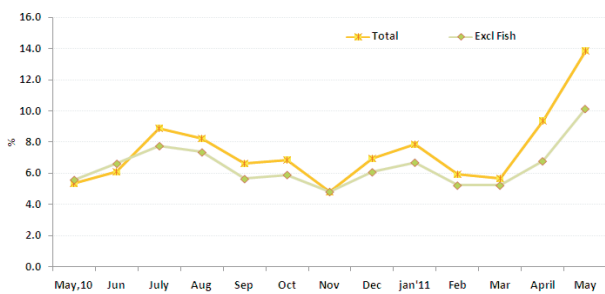

3. Inflation Rate of Male' (month on month): May '11 / May '10

To measure the month on month change at one point in time, the index of the month is compared with that of the same month in the preceding year (Eg: May '11 / May'10). The month on month index for May shows an inflation of 13.89% and the inflation excluding fish is 10.16%.

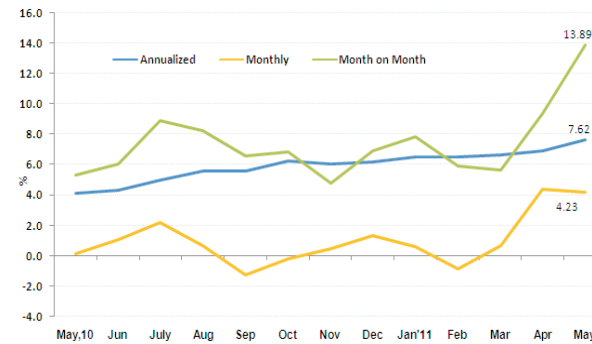
Inflation Rate of Male'

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) for Male' rose at an annualized rate of 7.62 percent in May 2011. The inflation was driven mainly by food excluding fish and housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels and fish categories. Additionally education, health and transport categories also contributed to this inflation.

Monthly CPI of May 2011 increased by 4.23 percent compared to April 2011. The inflation was mainly driven from food excluding fish and fish categories. Transport, health and housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels categories also contributed to this inflation.

When May 2011 is compared to May 2010, the consumer price index increased by 13.89 percent. Fish category showed the highest inflation followed by food excluding fish, education and transport categories.

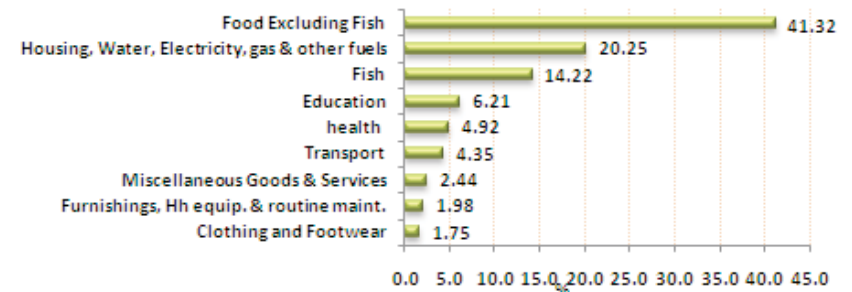
Figure 1: Inflation rates of Male' May 2011

Figure 2: Sources of changes in May CPI - Annualized



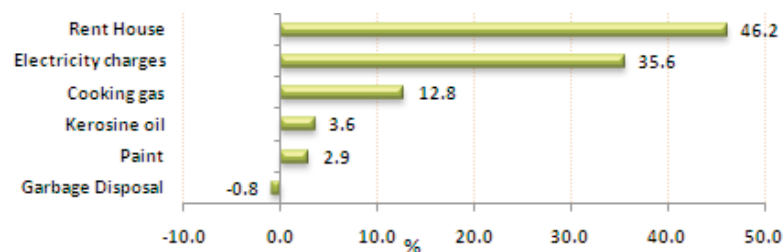
Main contributions to the change in the CPI - Annualized basis

The largest upward contribution to the change in the annualized CPI came from food excluding fish category which contributed 41%. Coconut and garlic prices went up by 76% and 60% respectively. Other items which showed a price increase above 25% were watermelon, green chilli, dhal, githiyo mirus (local chilli), cabbage, candy and lime. Items which registered a price change between 20% to 25% were orange, onion, ginger, aracanut, babyfood (fruit bottle) and jam.

The second largest upward contribution to the change in the annualized CPI came from housing, water, electricity, gas & other fuels category with 20%. Rent prices contributed highest to inflation of this category with 46%. Rent prices increased by 5%. Electricity prices contributed 36% to the inflation of housing category where the prices increased by 13%. Kerosine oil and cooking gas prices went up by 16% and 13% respectively.

Fish category contributed 14% to the overall annualized inflation. Skipjack tuna and little tuna prices increased by 50% and 48% respectively. Additionally reef fish and smoked fish prices also went up by 40% and 29% respectively. Canned fish prices went up by 18% during the period.

Change in the CPI - Month on Month

When May 2011 was compared to May 2010 most of the categories recorded an inflation. Fish category showed the highest inflation with 82.4% followed by food and beverages excluding fish category which registered 19.3%.

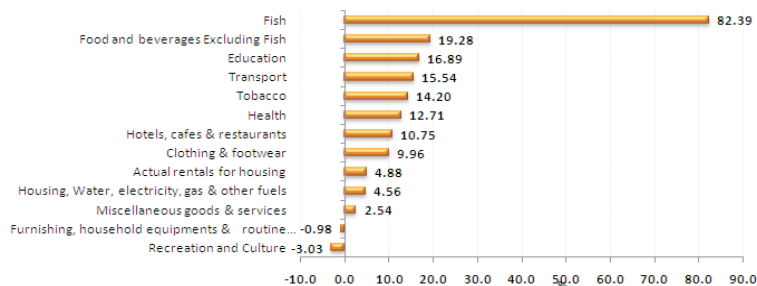
Skipjack tuna prices increased by 101% and little tuna and reef fish prices went up by 79% and 71% respectively. Smoked fish prices went up by 52% and canned fish prices rose by 28% when the two point of time were compared.

Food items which contributed most to the inflation were coconut, garlic, orange and aracanut which increased by 91%, 88%, 74% and 68% respectively. Other food items which showed a price difference above 50% were saltish short eats, watermelon, carrot and cooking oil. However githiyo mirus (local chilli), green chilli, candy and flour prices decreased by 29%, 21%, 15% and 12% respectively when the two point of time were compared.

School fee increased by 28% when May 2011 was compared to May 2010.

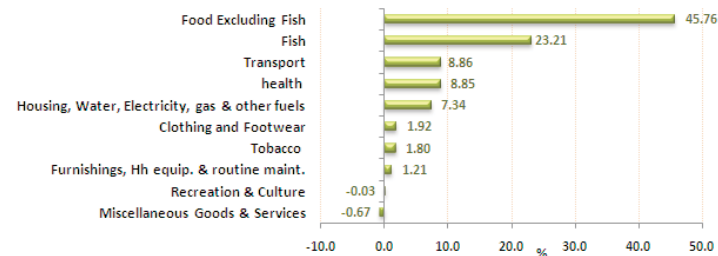
As for transport category petrol prices increased by 52% and international airfares increased by 29% during the period. Also domestic airfares increased by 24% and motor cycle prices went up by 12% when the two point of time were compared.

Food excluding fish and fish categories pulled up the monthly inflation by 46% and 23% respectively. Both transport and health categories also pulled up the overall monthly inflation by 9% followed by housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels category which contributed 7%.

As for transport category, motor cycle prices went up by 11% and international airfares went up by 9%. Additionally petrol prices went up by 8% in May 2011 when compared to April 2011.

The items which contributed most to the inflation of health category were specialist doctor's consultation fee and chest x-ray fee which showed a price increase of 15% and 14% respectively.

As for housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels category, cooking gas and plywood prices went up by 32% and 12% respectively in May 2011 when compared to April 2011.

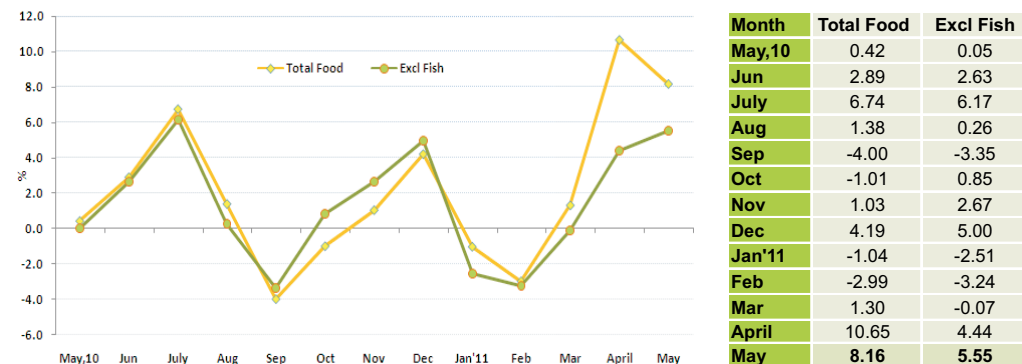
Monthly inflation rate of food and beverages category

The monthly inflation rate for the food category is 8.2%. Food excluding fish category showed an inflation of 5.6%.

As for food excluding fish category, carrot prices went up by 37% in May when compared to April. Saltish short-eats and Milk powder (Nido) prices went up by 33% and 30% respectively. Other items which showed a price increase above 15% were cabbage, small buns, onion, githiyo mirus, orange and canned mixed fruits. However candy and green chilli prices decreased by 43% and 34% respectively. Additionally water melon prices fell by 12% in May 2011 when compared to April 2011.

The items which contributed most to the 18% inflation of the fish category were little tuna and smoked fish, where the prices went up by 64% and 31% respectively. Additionally reef fish and skipjack tuna prices also increased by 23% and 21% during May 2011.
