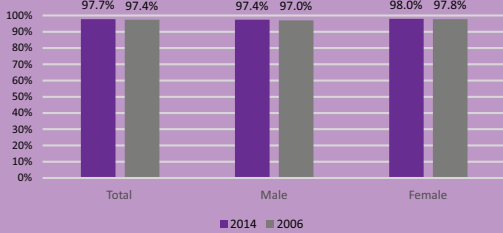

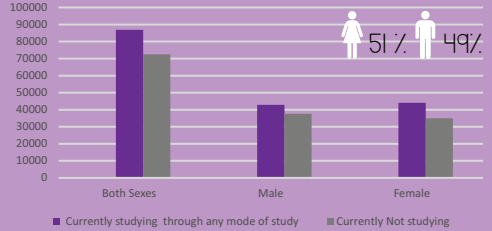

Literacy In Mother Tongue Of Resident Maldivian Population 10 Years Of Age And Over By Sex, 2006 And 2014



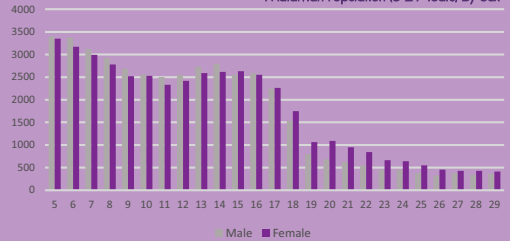

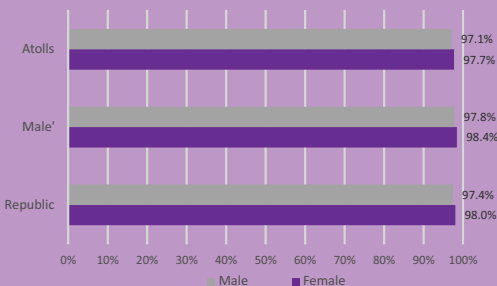

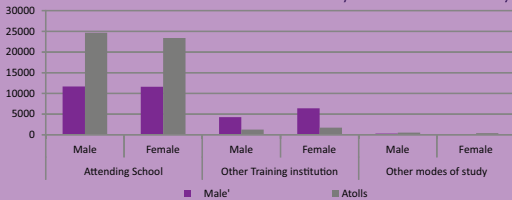

Figure 11: Attendance In Education Resident Maldivian Population (5-29 Years) By Mode Of Education And Locality

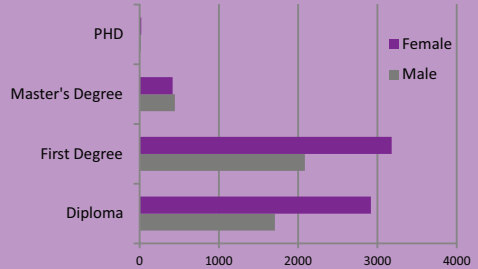

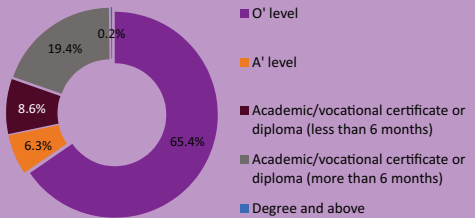

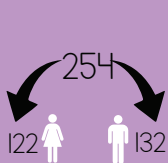
