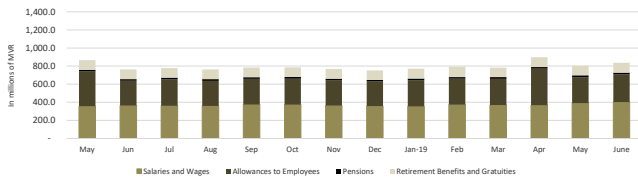
The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI increased by +0.24% in June 2019, compared to the increase of +0.24% in May 2019.

CPI increased at the All Group Levels in Male' by +0.53% and in Atolls by -0.02% in June 2019.

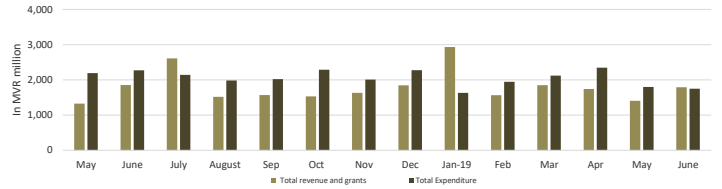
The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI increased by +1.59% through the year to June 2019, compared to the increase of +1.54% through the year to May 2019.

SALARIES, WAGES &amp; PENSIONS, 2018 - 2019



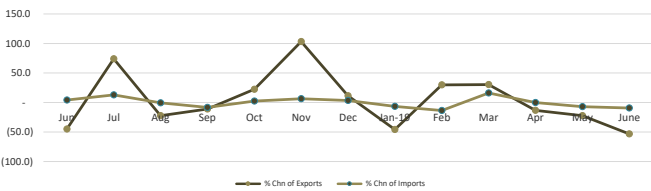
REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE OF GOVERNMENT- 2018 - 2019



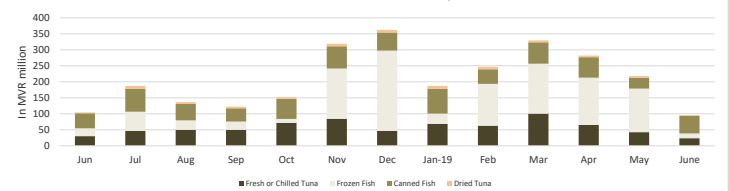

EXPORTS OF FISH PRODUCTS BY TYPE, 2018 - 2019



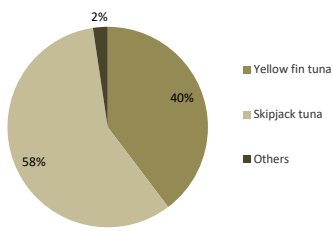

**IMPORTS:** The value of imports decreased by 9.2 percent in June 2019 when compared to May 2019. The total value of imports in June 2019 is 3,236.7 million MVR (cif).

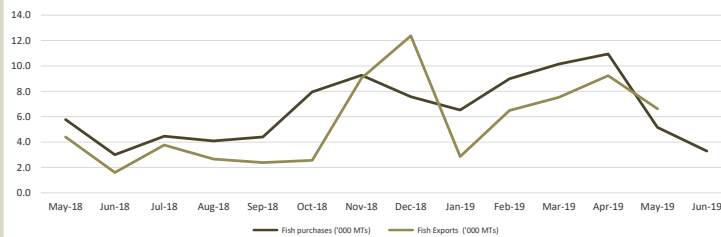

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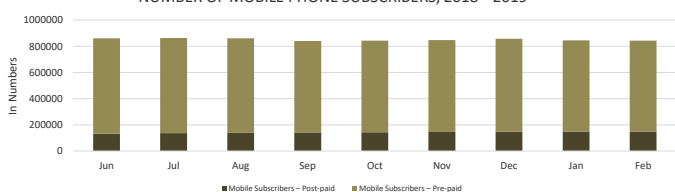

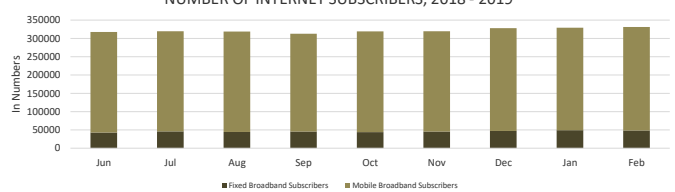

NUMBER OF MOBILE PHONE SUBSCRIBERS, 2018 - 2019



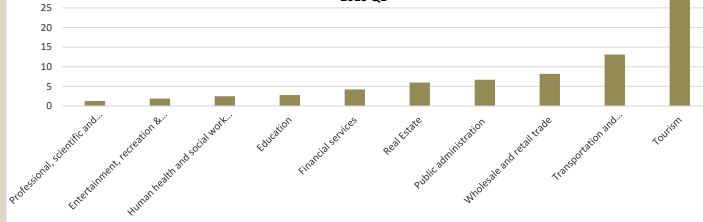
NUMBER OF INTERNET SUBSCRIBERS, 2018 - 2019



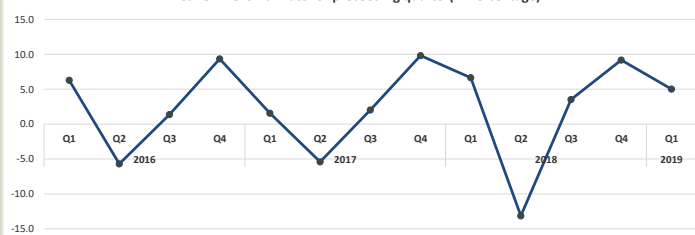
