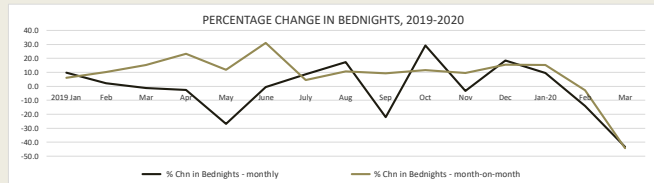
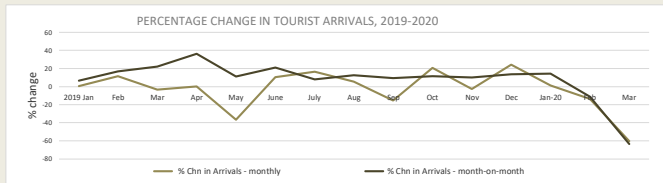

With travel restrictions enforced for key markets such as China, Germany, Italy, France, tourist arrivals for March 2020 is 59,627. This showed a huge decline of 60.2 percent compared to February 2020.

Due to COVID-19 outbreak, the top tourism market China tourists decline by 97% from 19,479 in March 2019 to only 498 in March 2020.

Bednights decreased by 43.2% in March 2020 compared to previous month, with a total of 562,539 bednights recorded in March 2020.

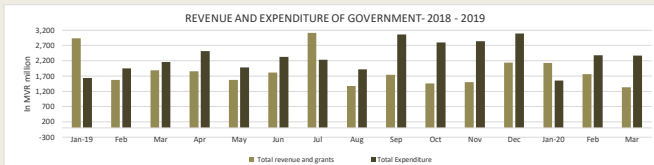
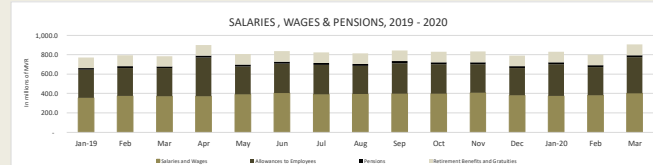
The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI fell by -1.12% in March 2020, compared to the rise of +0.001% in February 2020

The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI rose by +0.002% through the year to March 2020, compared to the rise of +0.91% through the year to February 2020

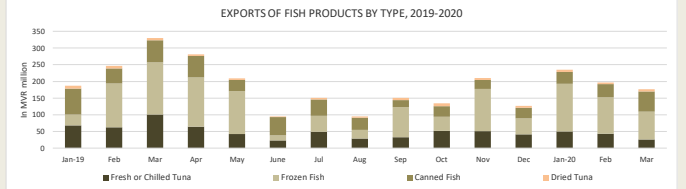
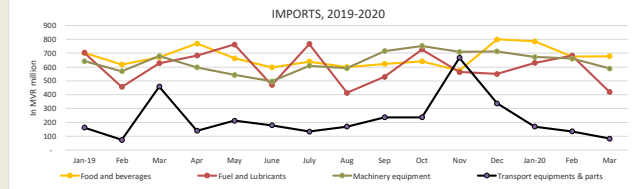
