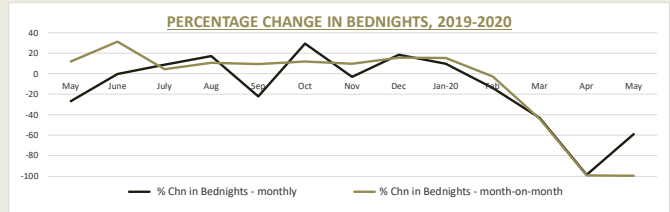
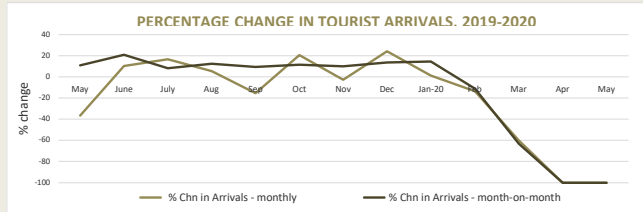

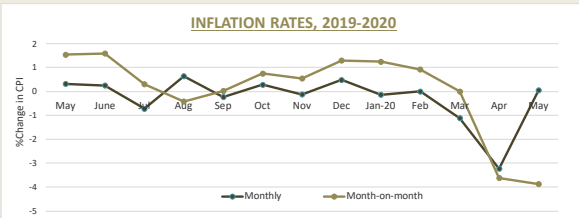
With the complete travel restrictions enforced and border being fully closed, there was no tourist arrivals for May 2020.

The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI rose by +0.05% in May 2020, compared to the fall by -3.23% in April 2020.

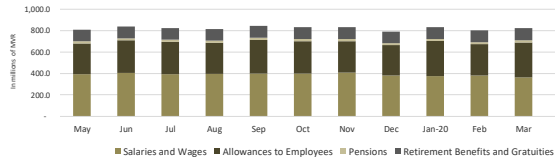
CPI fell at the All Group Levels in Male' by -0.06 and rose in Atolls by +0.20% in May 2020

The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI fell by -3.87% through the year to May 2020, compared to the fall of -3.62% through the year to April 2020.

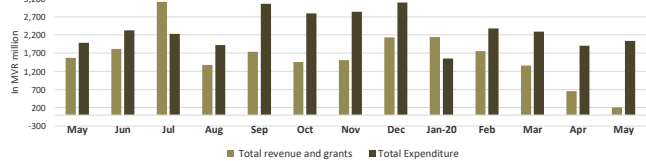

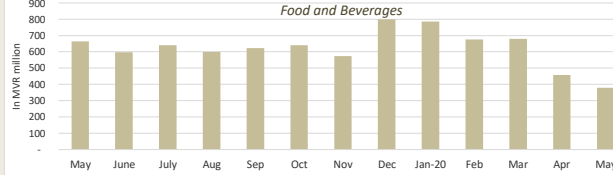
REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE OF GOVERNMENT- 2019 - 2020



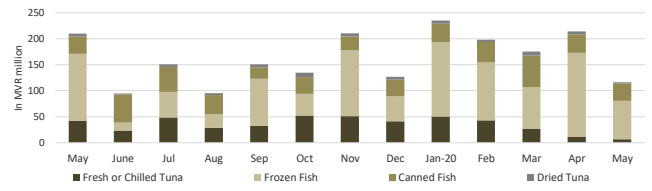

EXPORTS OF FISH PRODUCTS BY TYPE, 2019-2020

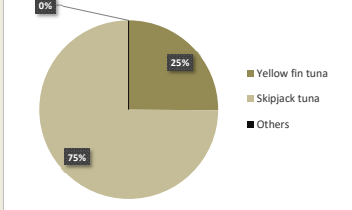

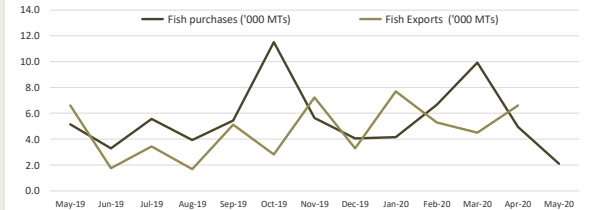
