### ATTITUDES


Participants were concerned about the health of the people and they sought reliable information when practicing recommended public health measures, on how to wash hands, how to practice social distancing and when to stay home.







### CONCERNS ABOUT HEALTH OF POPULATION GROUPS

From 17% who are concerned about violence at home, 1 in 6 people (16%) knows someone who experienced violence in the LAST week
