

### IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON ABILITY TO MEET FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS





### WENT TO WORK DURING LOCK-DOWN

1 in 10 were somewhat/not affected




### SOURCE OF INCOME BEFORE COVID-19
