
Study of Socio-Economic Aspects of COVID-19 Pandemic in the Maldives

This is the fourth release from the second round of the online survey of 2,517 participants with 2,368 complete responses (Round Two - June 2020).



Place of Work

23% of respondents do work home and 19% do not work at all




72% engaged in work outside home



Monthly Income before COVID-19

79% of the respondents earned more than MVR 15,000 before COVID-19




21% earns less than MVR 5000



Take-Home-Pay during Lockdown

56% of respondents had reduced or no income during lockdown



22% lost all income



Continuity of work

59% of respondents worked as before or partly during lockdown




41% were not able to work



Concerns Returning to Work

29% of respondents did not have any concerns while 7% had psychological or other concerns in returning to work



33% were concerned about COVID-19
