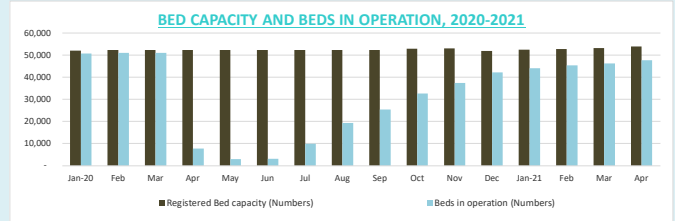
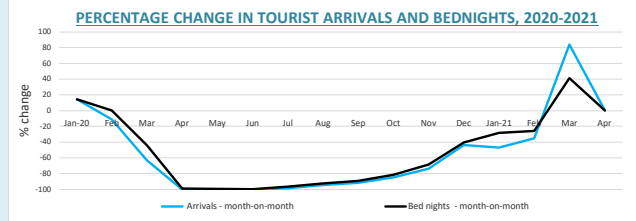

The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI rose by +3.35% through the year to April 2021, compared to the fall of -0.08% through the year to March 2021.

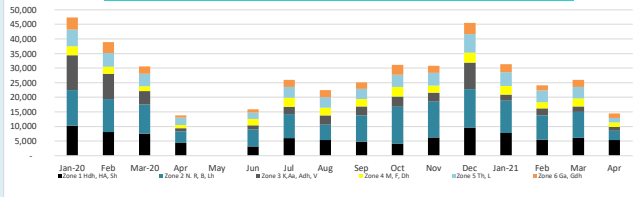

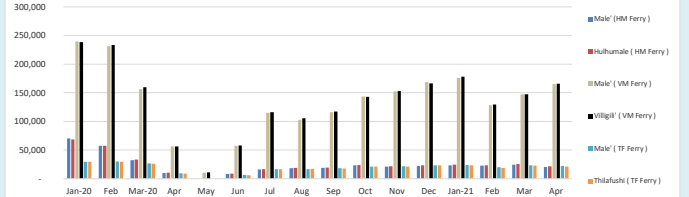

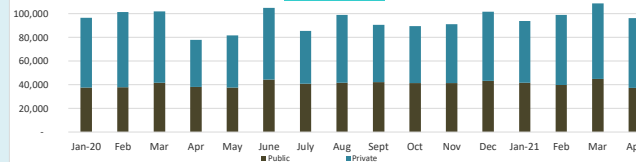

Electricity produced for Male' was 30,644 ('000 kWh) at the end of December 2020

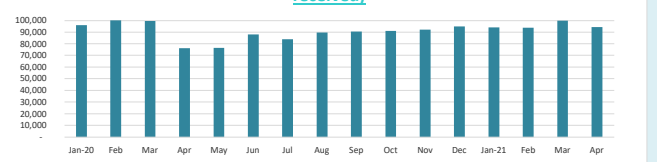

Maldives Retirement Pension Scheme Contributions (In '000 MVR)

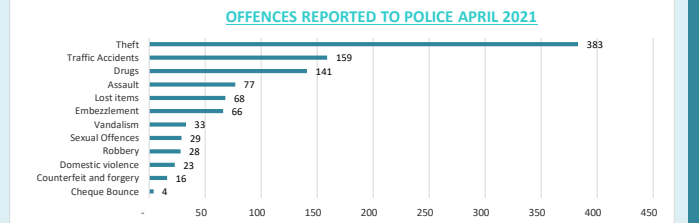
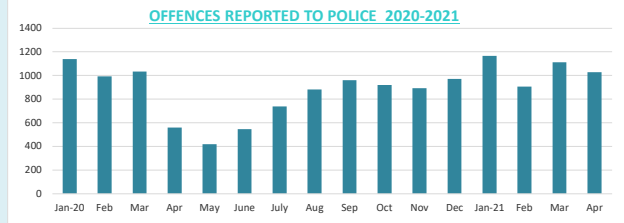


Employees of Retirement Pension Scheme (whose contributions received)

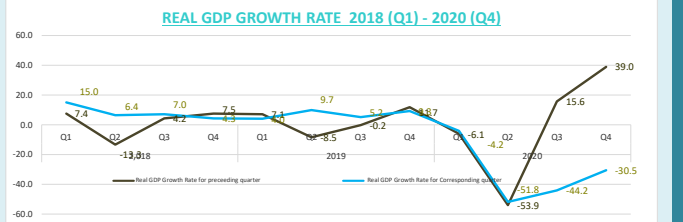
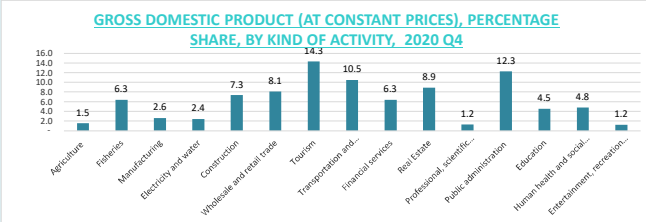
