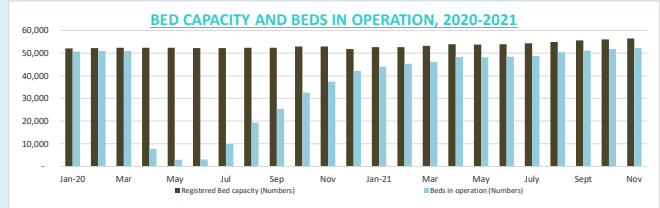
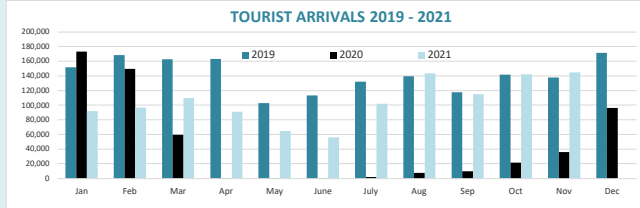

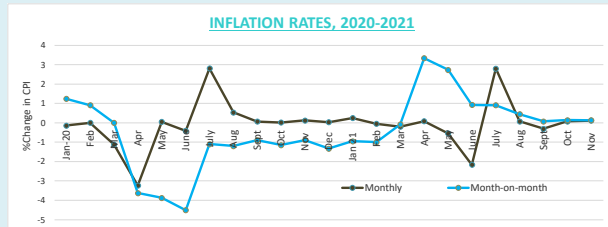


In November 2021, there were 144,735 tourist arrivals, where it showed an increase of 2 percent when compared to October 2021.

The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI rose by +0.13% through the year to November 2021, compared to the rise of +0.14% through the year to October 2021.

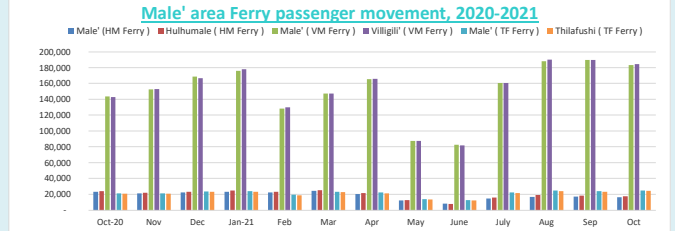
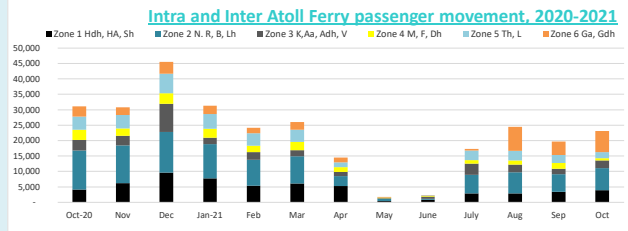
CPI rose at the All Group Levels in Male' by +0.23% and fell in Atolls by -0.03% in November 2021.

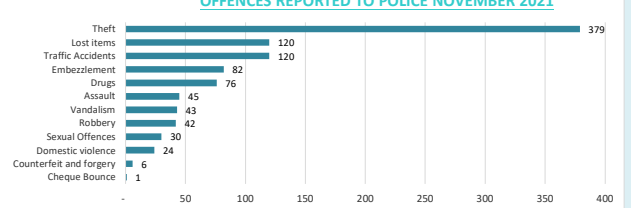

OFFENCES REPORTED TO POLICE NOVEMBER 2021



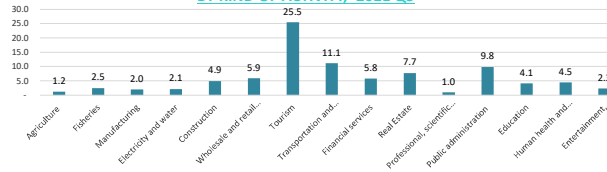

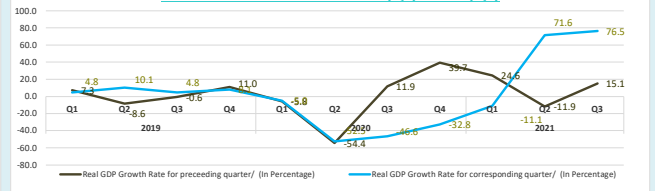
