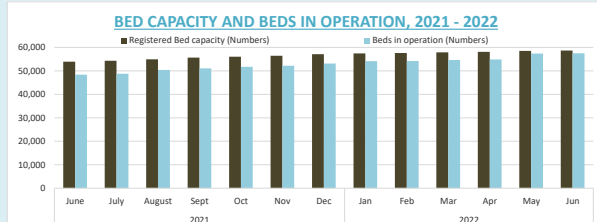

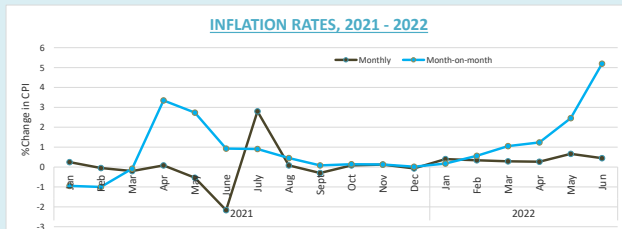


In June 2022, there were 110,889 tourist arrivals, where it showed a decline of 11.7 percent when compared to May 2022.

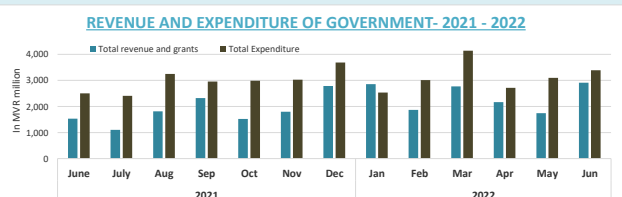
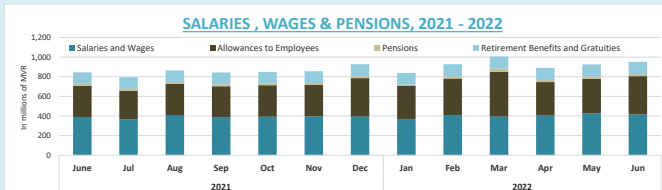
Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI rose by +0.45% in June 2022, compared to the increment of +0.67% in May 2022.

Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI rose by +5.19% through the year to June 2022, compared to the rise of +2.46% through the year to May 2022.

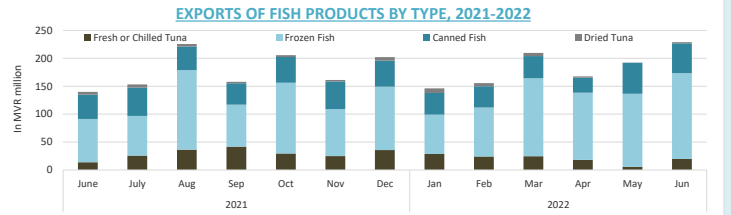
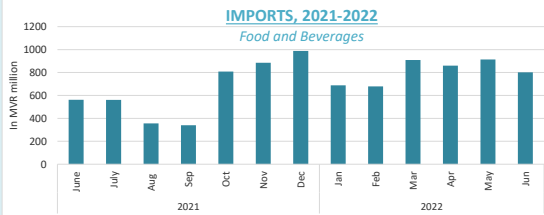

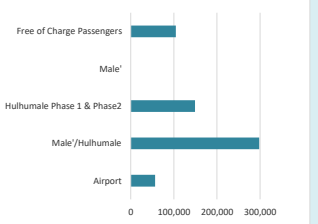
Intra and Inter atoll ferry passenger movement, 2022

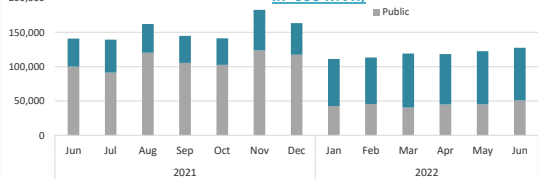

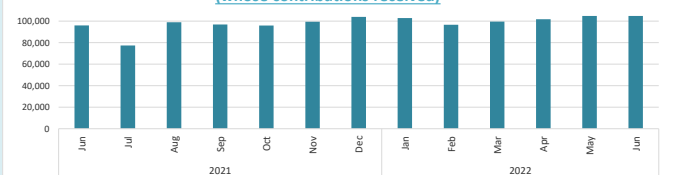

Maldives Retirement Pension Scheme Contributions, 2022 ( In '000 MVR)

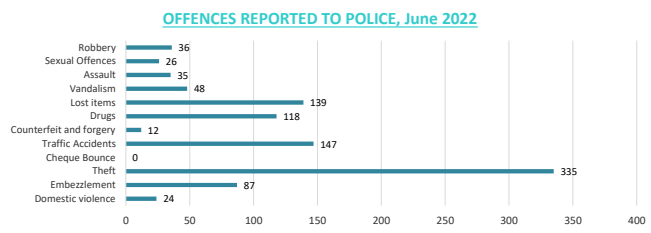
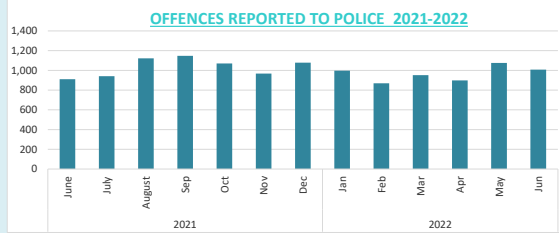


Employees of Retirement Pension Scheme (whose contributions received)

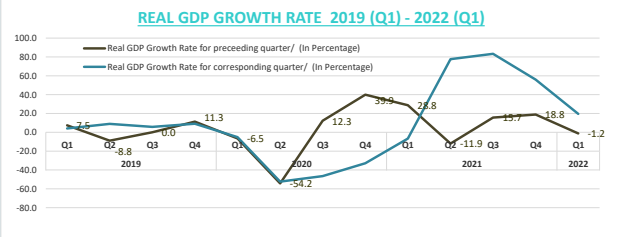
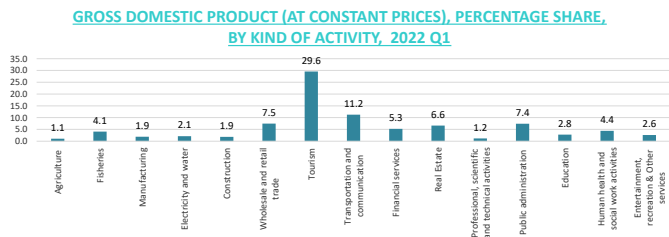
