

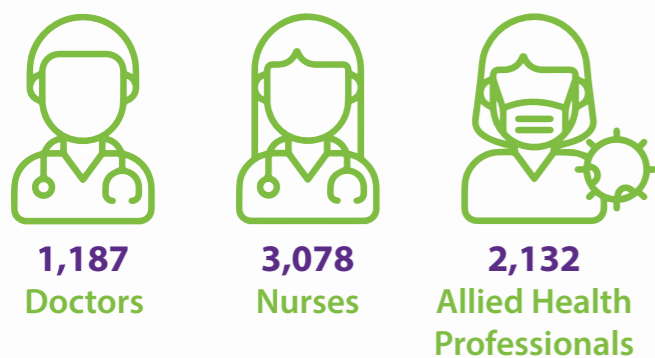

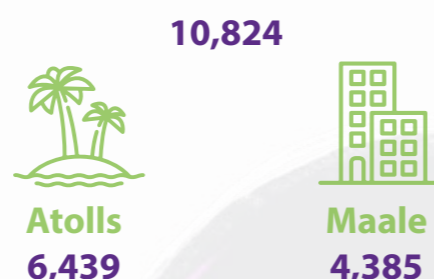


The right to health is a basic human right. Everyone must have access to the health services they need when and where they need them without financial hardship.

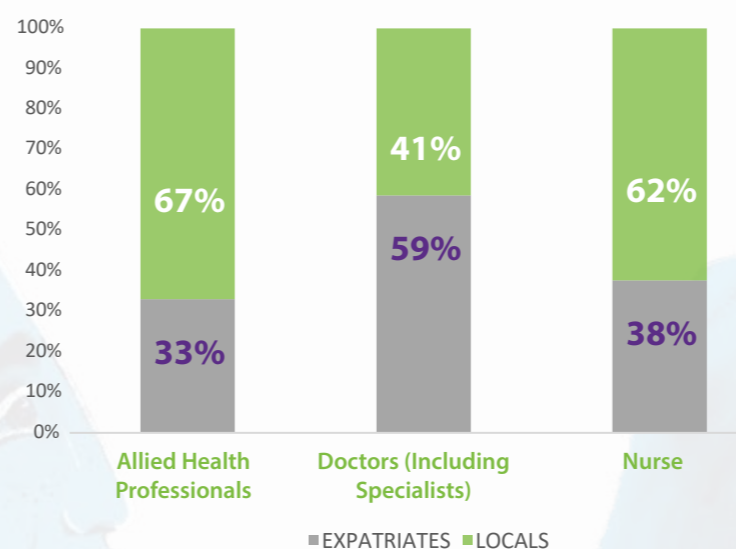
## HEALTH PROFESSIONALS 2021

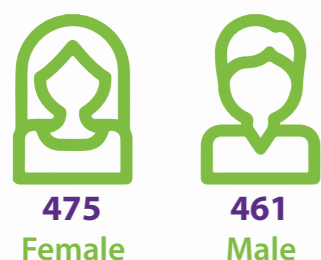

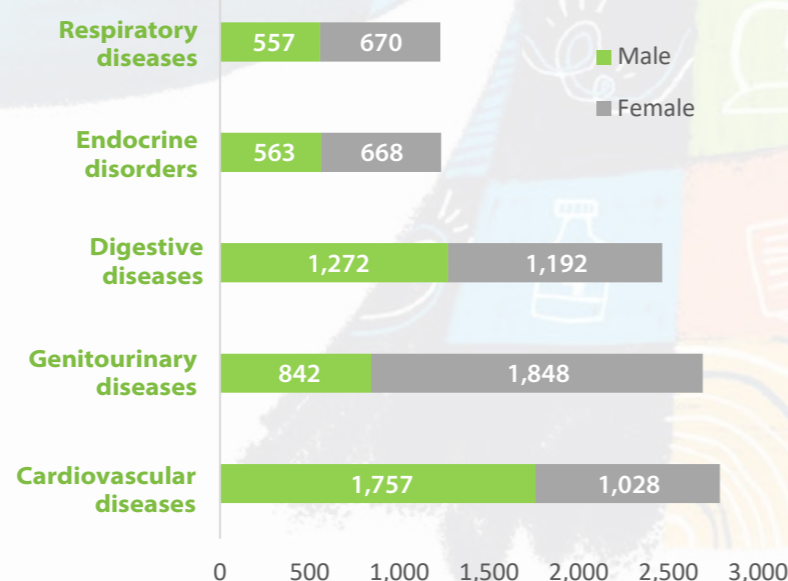

## NUMBER OF THALASSAEMIA CASES REGISTERED, 2022

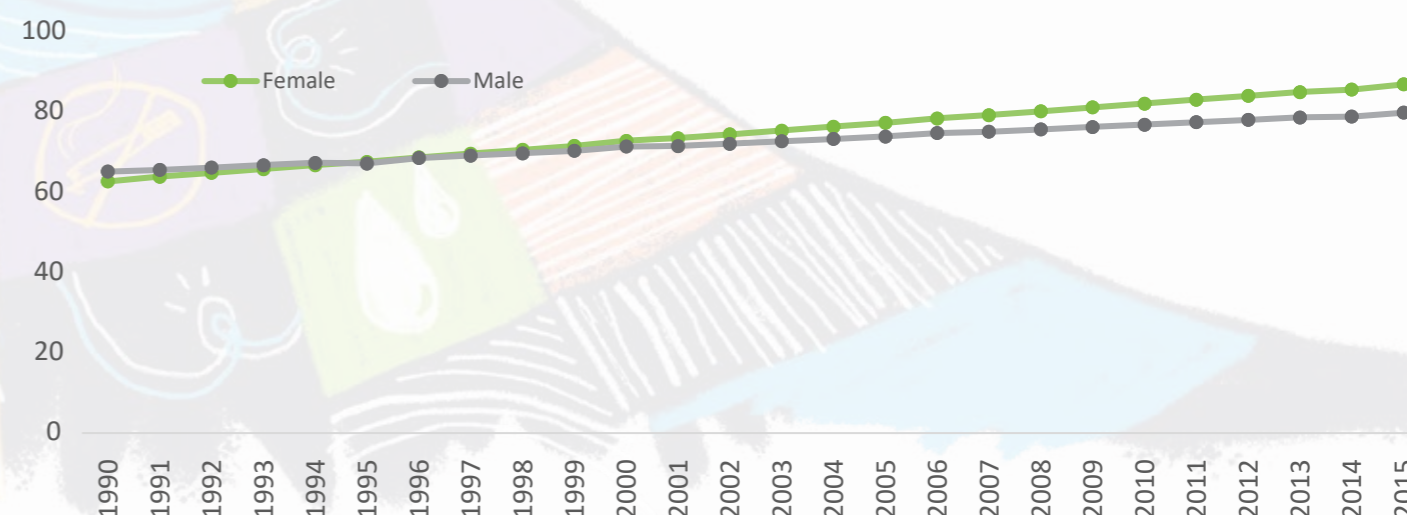


During the year 2021, 16 new thalassaemia cases were registered.

## TOP 5 NON-COMMUNICABLE DISEASE, 2020 (IN-PATIENT)

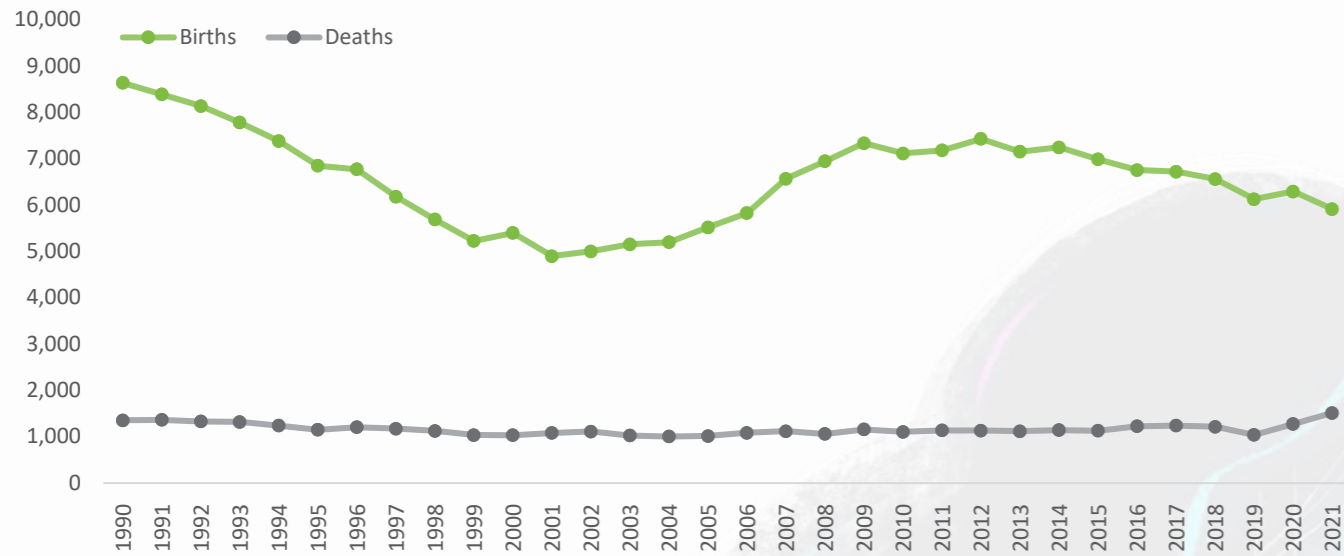


## IMPROVED LIFE EXPECTANCY AT BIRTH SERIES FOR MALDIVES, 1990-2015



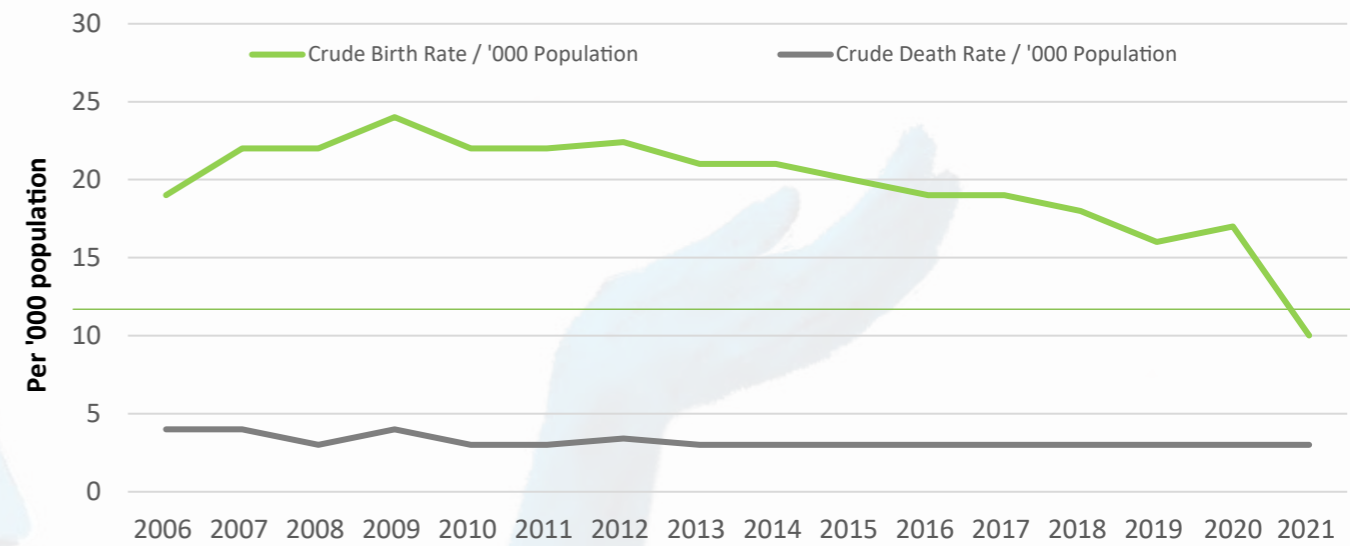
## HEALTH FOR ALL

### BIRTHS AND DEATHS, 1990 - 2021



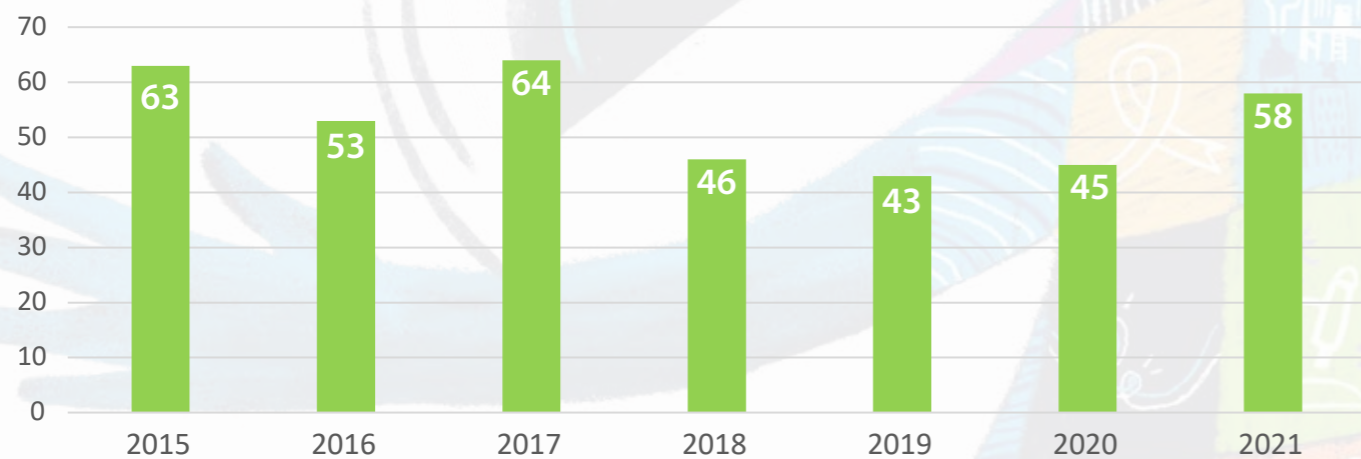
Births from 1990 until 2022 shows a decline over years and during the year 2001 a slight increase is seen, however from 2001 onwards the trend shows a gradual increase until 2009. This trend then is again seen decreasing until to date year by year. Number of death remains almost constant from 1990 until 2019, while a slight increase from 2019 until 2021 is observed.

### CRUDE BIRTH RATE AND CRUDE DEATH RATE, 2006-2021



Crude birth rate shows an increase from 2006 until 2009, however the rate gradually starts to decline from then until year 2021. Death rate shows a similar trend from 2006 until 2021 where the rate stays at an average rate of 4.

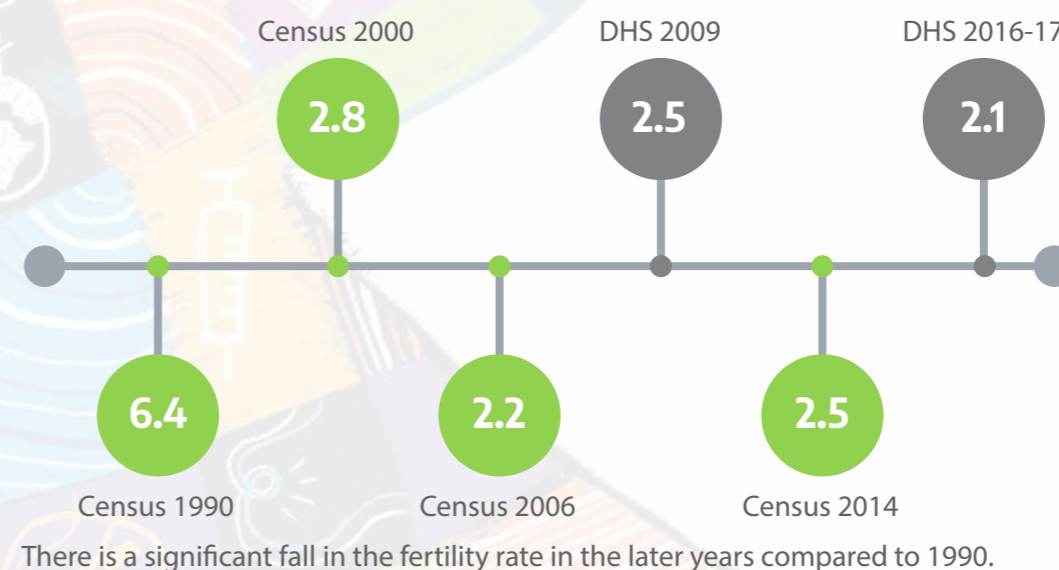
### INFANT DEATHS, 2015 - 2021



In 2021 a total of 58 children died before reaching their first birthday. This meant 10 infants died for every 1,000 live births in the country as seen from the infant mortality rate in 2021.

### FERTILITY, 1990 - 2017

Demographic Health Survey (DHS) 2016-17 & Census 2014



The total fertility rate (TFR) calculated in DHS 2016-17 is 2.1 children per woman, which means that the Maldives has reached what is known as replacement level fertility, or the level at which a population exactly replaces itself from one generation to the next.
