

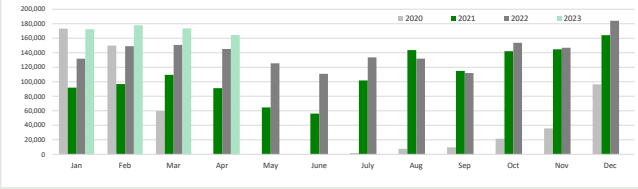

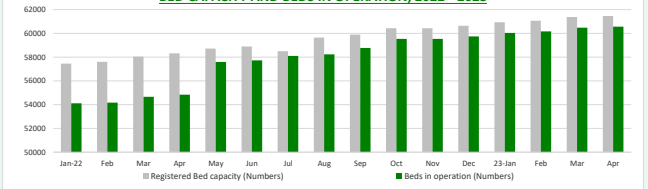

**BED CAPACITY AND BEDS IN OPERATION, 2022 - 2023**

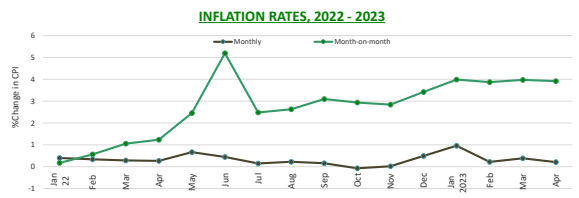


In April 2023, there were 164,357 tourist arrivals, where it showed a decline of 5.3 percent when compared to March 2023. The Bednights for April 2023 recorded was 1,182,069 showing a decline of 5.3 percent compared to March 2023. In April 2023 the registered bed capacity was 61,458 where the beds in operation stood at 60,562.

In April 2023, the Consumer Price Index excluding fish rose by +0.28%, compared to the increase of +0.34% in March 2023.

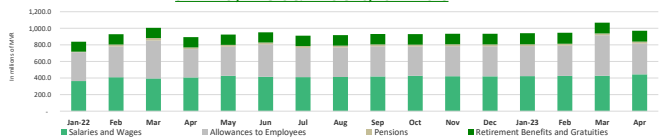
The Consumer Price Index for all groups CPI rose by +3.91% through the year to April 2023, compared to the rise of +3.97% through the year to March 2023.

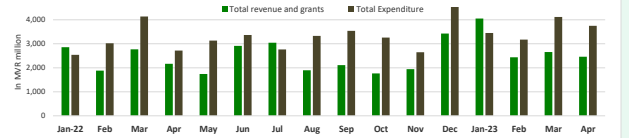

**REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE OF GOVERNMENT - 2022 - 2023**

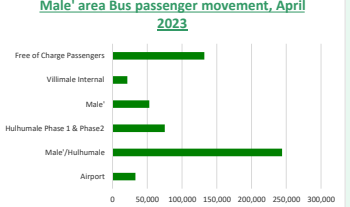
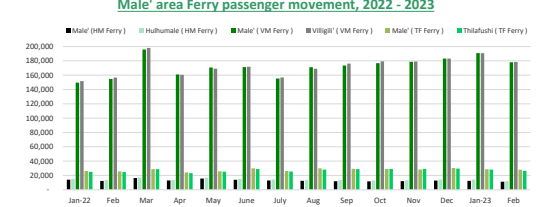
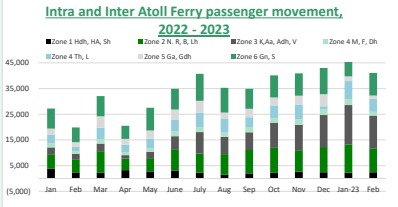
