 Maldivian Blood Services is the parental body of Thalassaemia and Other Hemoglobinopathies Centre (TOHC) and Central Blood Bank (CBB)  
 Thalassaemia and Other Hemoglobinopathies Centre was formed under Thalassaemia Control Act ( 4 / 2012 ) which was ratified by President on 10 May 2012  
 By law a new register had to be formed and maintained from 10 May 2012 onwards
